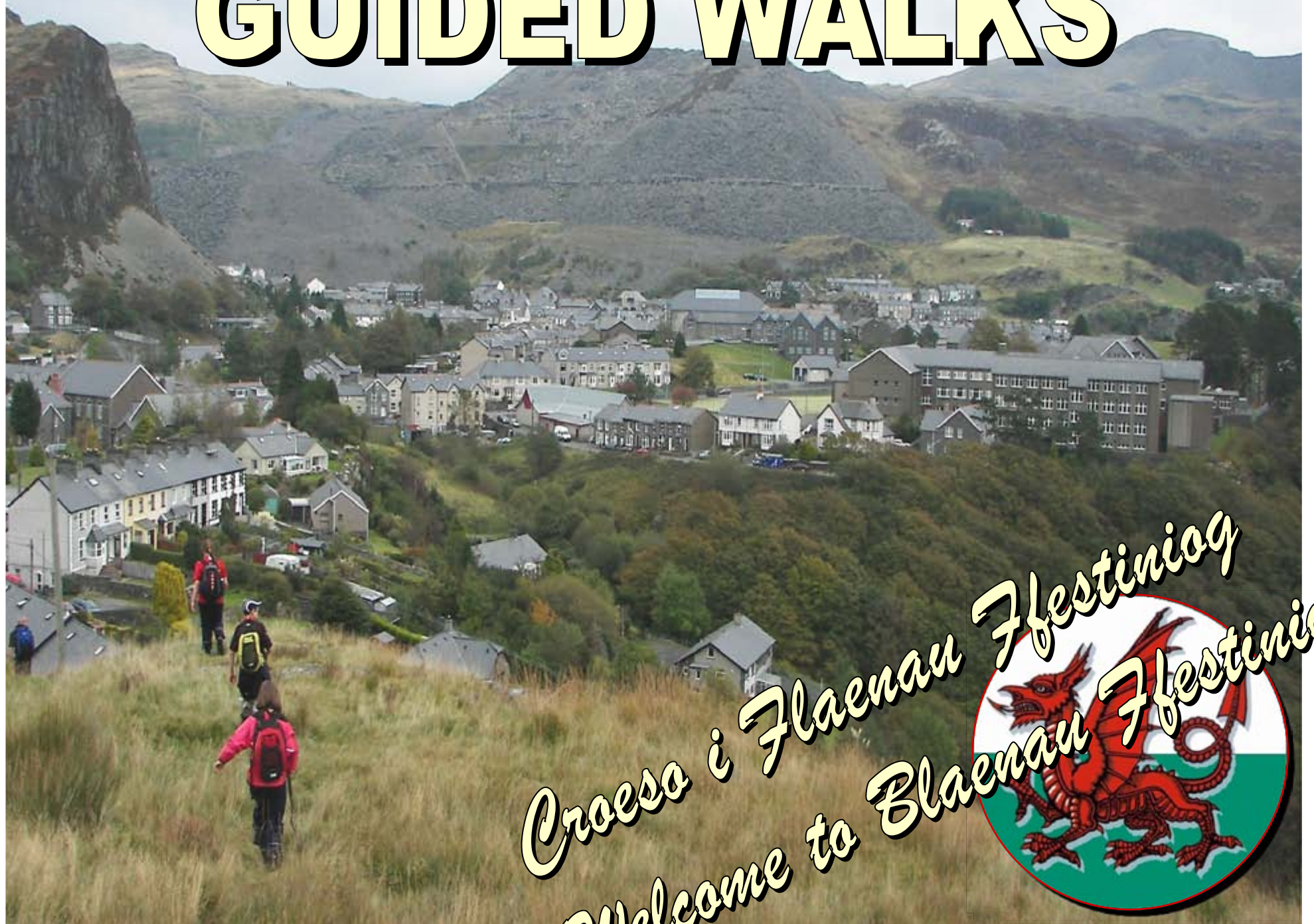


# BLAENAU FFESTINIOG

### **STATION / QUARRY WALK**

*Journey up to the quarry incline, past the original Diffwys railway station, and the Inkpot house.  
See the remnants of slate heritage. Stunning views of Blaenau Ffestiniog and its valley.*

### **CWM BOWYDD VALLEY WALK**

*A woodland walk, full of the wonders of nature, passing by the Cwm Bowydd farm built in the late seventeenth century.  
Learn Welsh names and their meaning - finish the walk by ordering a cup of tea in one of Britain's oldest languages!*
