

## **FOOD HYGIENE TRAINING**

## Advisory leaflet for proprietors of food businesses

Food Safety Regulations<sup>1</sup> now state:

"Food business operators are to ensure:

- 1. that food handlers are supervised and instructed and/ or trained in food hygiene matters commensurate with their work activity;
- 2. that those responsible for the development and maintenance of the procedure referred to in Article 5(1) of this regulation<sup>1</sup> [HACCP] or for the operation of relevant guides have received adequate training in the application of HACCP principles;

and

3. compliance with any requirements of national law concerning training programmes for persons working in certain food sectors.

Meeting these requirements is about having the skills etc to carry out food handling and preparation in a manner that does not compromise food safety. Ensuring management and food handling staff receive formal food hygiene training contributes greatly to ensuring safe food is produced and sold. It also helps a business to comply with their legal requirements.

Should you or your staff require such training, overleaf is a list of known local food hygiene trainers. We do not recommend particular training companies and have not carried out any checks to ensure those listed are competent or registered to run their courses. We have simply listed those that we know of.
