Tell Us Once - a government initiative to help those who are bereaved

Tell Us Once is a free government service that allows you to report a death when you suffer a bereavement and need to tell central and local government.

When someone has died, there are lots of things that need to be done, at a time when you probably least feel like doing them. This will include contacting Government departments and local council services that need to be informed.

- DWP Pensions and Benefits
- Personal Tax
- Council Tax
- Passport
- Driving Licence
- Blue Badge
- Electoral Register
- Public Sector Pensions

You will need to contact your Register Office in advance of using the Tell Us Once service which will normally be when you register the death.
