WORK PROGRESSING ON SITE AT THE CAERHUN AND TREFRIW NEW AREA SCHOOL



The construction of the Caerhun and Trefriw new area school is progressing, with the school beginning to take shape. Construction, the external and internal blockwork, including steel beams, have been completed to Zone 1 (Lower Ground Floor and First Floor) with the same works near completion in Zone 2 (Ground Level). Indeed, the recent fair weather has aided the progress and if continues will assist with the work programmed in for the next 4 week period. This work includes the installation of roof trusses, and the start of roof coverings which once completed will ensure the building is watertight and another major milestone for the project.

Off site, the new Headteacher and Temporary Governing Body are progressing with the staff structure for the new school along with the new school logo and uniform. The next scheduled meeting for the Temporary Governing Body is July where school name ideas will be discussed in more detail.
