#### What can you do to help if I am sleeping outdoors?

Local Authorities do not always have a duty to provide temporary accommodation, but do have a duty to provide advice, assistance and an assessment of your needs to help prevent and/or relieve your homelessness.

#### Are there any other services to support & advise me?

Our partner agencies (below) can offer a range of advice and support. You can access the internet at your local library or at the Coed Pella Offices to make contact.

#### **Direct Access Shelters**

There is a Direct Access Shelter: Ty Golau, Clwyd Buildings, Clwyd Street, Rhyl, LL18 3LA. 201745 345900. You need to be there by 6.45pm to request shelter. There is demand for beds so consider arriving early. To be eligible you need to be homeless, 18 years old + and have some ID or Nat Ins Number and have a connection to Denbighshire. If there is less demand for beds they may consider you without a local connection.

There is also **Ty Nos** — Wrexham Night Shelter, which is at the old Maes Y Dre 01978 262 222 (day time enquiries)

# **Community Support and Charities**



The Kind Bay Initiative is a community group set up to add some kindness into Colwyn Bay and the wider community. They provide a weekly get together to help tackle homelessness, isolation, loneliness and poor mental health. Provide free hot food, warm clothes. entertainment and support. Every Sunday 1pm – 3pm there is live music, barber service and crafts activities once a month. Also providing emergency food parcels when possible.

Kind Bay can also provide you will a cup and sachets of drinks or powdered soup and work with local companies to provide the 'Refill & Stir' initiative. All you need to do is take your cup to one of these locations and they will give you hot water to add to your sachets:

#### FoodShare Colwyn & Pensarn with HopeGiver.org.uk

Helps those in food poverty in the Colwyn Bay / Old Colwyn and Pensarn area, helping those with low budgets to purchase food. For a weekly membership of £3.50 they will provide up to £15-worth of food, or up to £10 of food for £2.50 or £5 of food for £1.50 every week. You just need to turn up, sign up, and pick up your food every week. The FoodShare Club is run in partnership with and based at:

Register with the FoodShare Club for a subscription charge (for each week you attend) of £1.50 - £3.50, and take home food up to the value of £15.00, depending on your chosen subscription. A Job Club is available - Just drop in and use the laptops to search for jobs, help is on hand to support you and help update your CV.
