Active Travel (Wales) Act 2013 – Existing Routes Map and Integrated Network Map submission

Following the submission by your authority to the Welsh Government of the Existing Routes Map and Integrated Network Map under provisions within sections 3 (1) and 4 (1) of the Active Travel (Wales) Act 2013, I can confirm that the Welsh Ministers have approved both maps.

If you have any routes which interface the trunk road, these will need to be subject to separate discussions with Welsh Government Network Management Team.

I expect you to pay regard to section 4 of the statutory Delivery Guidance when publishing your maps.

Please keep your maps under review as you will need to submit revised versions no later than three years from the date of this letter. You should continue to improve your active travel network plans, increasing the density and addressing any gaps before your next submission.
