



## Llwybrau Teithio Llesol

### ARGYMHELLION GAN GYNGOR TREF ABERGELE

#### 1. PROMENÂD PENSARN

Canran uchel o bobl â chŵn, pramiau, beicwyr ar y llwybr beicio a phobl yn gyrru sgwteri symudedd. Mae cynllun y ffyrdd i'w weld yn awgrymu dau lwybr gwahanol o Abergele ar un ochr a Phensarn ar y llall, gan arwain at y Prom yn unig, ond mae angen croesi'r ffordd ddwywaith ar lwybr trwodd o Ffordd y Môr at Orsaf Abergele wrth gerdded er mwyn aros ar y palmant. Mae angen rhoi ystyriaeth i'r bont gefngrwm, y tro sydyn a rheolaeth ar draffig er mwyn i'r Llwybr Teithio Llesol fod yn un DIOGEL.

#### 2. PARC BUSNES CAE EITHIN

Sicrhau bod y fynedfa a grëwyd i Heol Awel at ddefnydd cerddwyr a beicwyr yn unig, nid i gerbydau.

#### 3. Trwy STAD TAN-Y-GOPA MARKET ST (Llwybr Cerdded 6)

Y llwybrau cerdded o ochr orllewinol Abergele Grill drwy'r stad i ben Tan-y-Gopa.

## ACTIVE TRAVEL ROUTES

### RECOMMENDATIONS FROM ABERGELE TOWN COUNCIL

#### 1. PENSARN PROMENADE

High percentage of people with dogs, pushchairs, cyclists on the cycle path and people driving mobility scooters. The design of the roads seems to assume two separate routes from Abergele one side and Pensarn the other leading solely to the Prom, but a through-route from Sea Road to Abergele Station on foot requires crossing the road twice in order to stay on a pavement. The hump back bridge, sharp bend and traffic control all need review to enable a SAFE Active Travel Route.

#### 2. CAE EITHIN BUSINESS PARK

To ensure access created to Heol Awel is exclusively for use by pedestrians and cyclists and not vehicular access.

#### 3. Through TAN-y-GOPA ESTATE MARKET ST (Footpath 6)

The pedestrian cut through passages from the western side of Abergele Grill through the estate to the top of Tan-y-Gopa

#### 4. LON GARNEDD to MARKET St

The short alleyway from (Eastern side of the Abergele Grill)

#### 5. HARP PATH

Starts from a gap in the houses on Llwyn Onn and leads through the estate to the back of the Harp Inn and emerging onto Market St.

#### 6. Bryngwenallt to Llanfair Road (Footpath 16)

Signposting      Ensure road safety where the path passes through residential and ultimately where it meets Llanfair Road

#### 7. BRYN TWR to BRIDGE ST

The footpath from along Gele River.

Upgrade to same standard as on the coastal path      Signposting

Lighting      Shrubbery and weeding cut back



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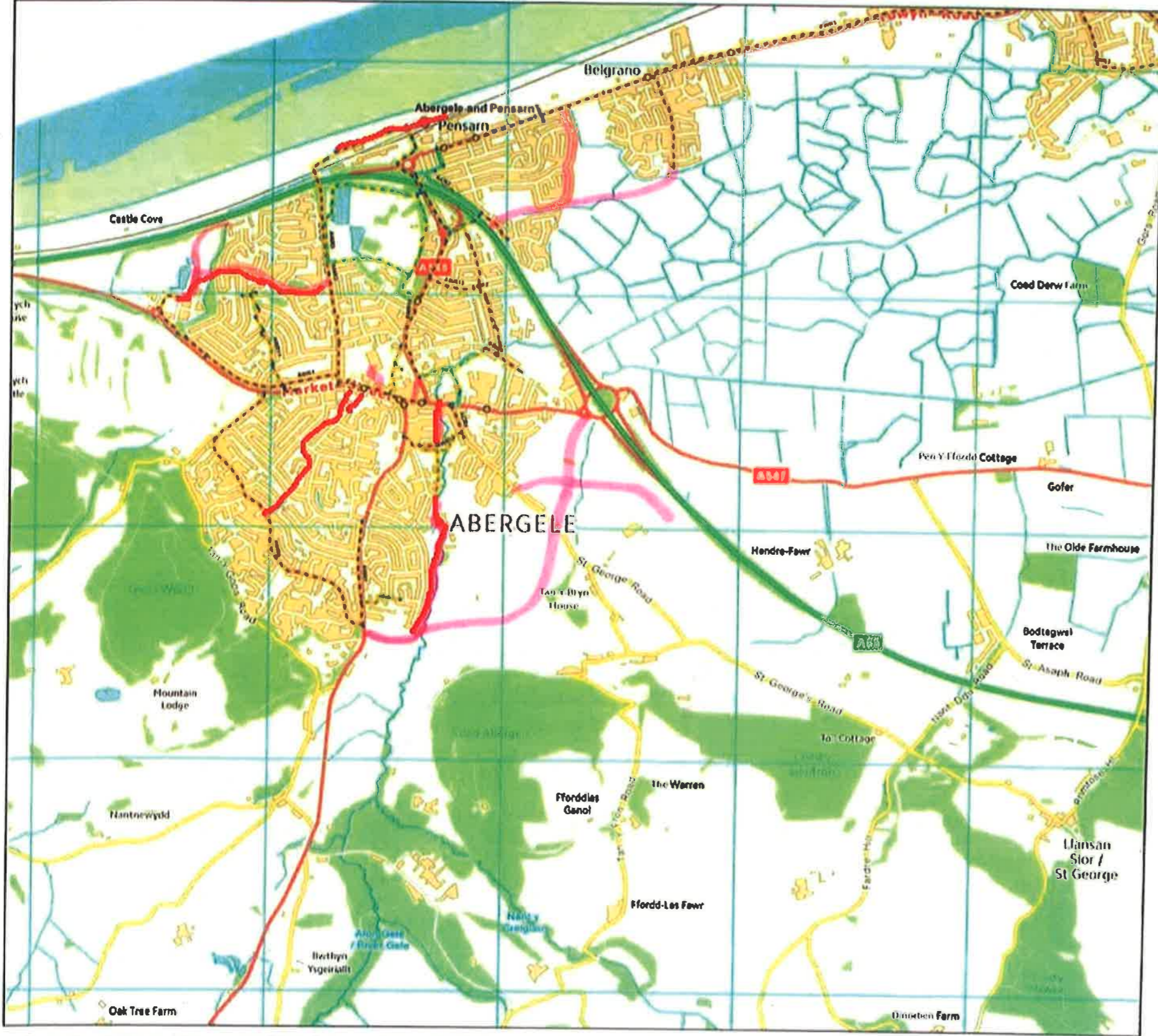

**Active Travel Routes / Llwybrau Teithio Llesol**

- Pedestrian zone / Aidal oerdded
- Pedestrian and cycle zone / Aidal oerdded a belolo
- Road without footway / Ffordd heb droedffordd
- Line end points / Pwyntiau diwedd llinell
- Integrated Network / Rhwydwaith Integredig
- Crossings / Croesfannau
