They are spread over a period of four sessions for four to five weeks in a small group setting with other carers delivered by a trained member of staff.

You have the opportunity to gain a better understanding of dementia, have an overview of the financial and legal implications, identify local support and care services, and look at practical ways of supporting someone experiencing difficulties associated with dementia.
