****Renewal Processing Timescales ****

Please can we ask that you renew at least 7 days before your license expiry date so that we can process the application and have your plates out for you to be able to trade after the expiry date, you will not be permitted to drive with expired plates on the vehicle. Temporary Screens in Taxis and Private Hire Vehicles Policy

The Council's conditions of licence require any modifications to the vehicle to be approved by the licensing authority.
