WHAT IS IT?

Within half a mile of the coastal resort of Llandudno stands one of the most spectacular country parks in Wales, blessed with some of the best views and most diverse wildlife you may ever come across.

Rising like a dragon's head from the sea, it has attracted countless generations of people, from Bronze Age miners prospecting for rich mineral seams to enthusiastic Victorian families drawn to the combination of beautiful surroundings and the Great Orme's wealth of historical interest.

 At the Visitor Centre, open between March and October, you can find out much more about this unique headland.

Mae hanes pobl ar y Gogarth yn hynod o ddiddorol - o Oes y Cerrig cynnar hyd at heddiw. Mae dros bedwar can safle o ddiddordeb hanesyddol.

Human history on the Great Orme is extremely interesting: spanning a period of time from the early Stone Age through to modern times. There are over four hundred sites of historical interest.

Mae gan y Gogarth gyfoeth o fywyd gwylt amrywiol. Mae'r Ardal Gadwraeth Arbennig hon yn cynnal anferth o flodau gwylt a gloynnod byw, rhai ohonynt yn brin iawn, a llu o adar ymfudol a bridio.

The wildlife of the Great Orme is rich and varied. This Special Area of Conservation (SAC) supports an enormous variety of wild flowers and butterflies, some of which are very rare, and a whole host of breeding and migrant birds.
