



Native Replacement Planting:

Native species found locally to inform replacement planting mixes:

- *Acer campestre* (Field maple)
- *Alnus glutinosa* (Alder)
- *Betula pendula* (Silver birch)
- *Cornus sanguinea* (Common dogwood)
- *Corylus avellana* (Hazel)
- *Crataegus monogyna* (Hawthorn)
- *Ilex aquifolium* (Holly)
- *Malus sylvestris* (Common apple)
- *Populus tremula* (Aspen)
- *Prunus avium* (Wild cherry)
- *Prunus spinosa* (Blackthorn)
- *Quercus robur* (Pedunculate oak)
- *Rosa canina* (Dog rose)
- *Salix alba* (White willow)
- *Salix caprea* (Goat willow)
- *Salix cinerea* (Grey willow)
- *Salix fragilis* (Crack willow)
- *Sambucus nigra* (Elder)
- *Sorbus aucuparia* (Rowan)
- *Ulex europaeus* (Gorse)
- *Ulmus glabra* (Wych elm)
- *Viburnum opulus* (Guelder rose)

Planning Policy Wales (Edition 12, paragraph 6.4.42)

Replacement planting shall be at a ratio equivalent to the quality, environmental and ecological importance of the tree(s) lost and this must be preferably onsite, or immediately adjacent to the site, and at a minimum ratio of at least 3 trees of a similar type and compensatory size planted for every 1 lost. Where a woodland or a shelterbelt area is lost as part of a proposed scheme, the compensation planting must be at a scale, design and species mix reflective of that area lost. In such circumstances, the planting rate must be at a minimum of 1600 trees per hectare for broadleaves, and 2500 trees per hectare for conifers.

Recommended tree replacement according to the Tree Protection Plan [MITIGATION] (TEP ref: D10313.01.009):

69 individual trees to replace the 23 individual trees lost
 1.47ha of broadleaf tree cover to replace the 0.92ha of tree cover lost

Caveats:

- Retained trees shown as illustrated on the Arboricultural Impact Plans (TEP ref: D10313.01.001.012).
- Proposals subject to further discussion with landowners and consultees.
- Proposals subject to further ground survey and review of site constraints as information becomes available, including lighting, drainage and utilities.
