Gorchymyn Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (Ffyrdd Amrywiol Towyn & Bae Cinmel) (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros) 2026

Rheswm y Cyngor dros wneud y Gorchymyn bwriedig yw:-

- cynnal llif esmwyth traffig a gwella diogelwch ar y ffyrdd

Mae Heddlu Gogledd Cymru wedi gofyn am newidiadau i gyfyngiadau Gaingc Road a Sandbank Road gan y gall parcio ar y strydoedd hynny mewn darnau cul achosi rhwystr drwy gydol y flwyddyn. Mae Maes y Llan wedi'i gynnwys oherwydd ei agoswydd, er mwyn cynnal cysondeb.

Mae'r newidiadau arfaethedig yn St Asaph Avenue yn ganlyniad i newidiadau i gynllun y ffordd a wnaed ar gyfer gwaith amddiffyn rhag llifogydd, ar ôl cael caniatâd cynllunio.

Bail parcio cyffredinol i bobl anabl wedi'i gynnig yn The Square (De Orllewin) yn dilyn cais gan y gymuned.

Cynigir cyfyngiadau parcio ar strydoedd preswyl yn Horton's Nose, Park Avenue a Gwelyn Avenue Bae Cinmel i atal rhwystr gweledol a/neu gorfforol yn y manau cyffordd.

Cynigir cyfyngiadau ar gartrefi modur dros nos yn Horton's Nose i atal rhwystr gweledol a/neu gorfforol ac i warchod amwynder yr ardal

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The County Borough of Conwy (Various Roads Towyn & Kinmel Bay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2026

The Council's reason for making the proposed Order is:-

- maintain the free flow of traffic and improve road safety

North Wales Police have requested changes to Gaingc Road and Sandbank Road restrictions as parking on those streets in narrow stretches can cause an obstruction all year round. Maes y Llan included due it's proximity, to maintain consistency.

Proposed changes at St Asaph Avenue are a consequence of road layout changes carried out for flood defence works, having obtained planning approval.

General disabled parking bays proposed at The Square (South West) following community request.

Parking restrictions on residential streets at Horton's Nose, Park Avenue and Gwellyn Avenue Kinmel Bay proposed to prevent visual and/ or physical obstruction at the junction areas.

Overnight motorhome restrictions proposed at Horton's Nose to prevent visual and/ or physical obstruction and to conserve the amenity of the area.
