## 5. Child to Parent Carer Abuse (CPCA): Practitioner Pathway Flowchart

Agency concern about a child or adult re CPCA (child under 16 years old):

Referring agency to complete TLST and refer to MASH if scoring Amber or Red.

Note as concern if scoring Green.

MASH to screen within **24 hours**: Adult & child safeguarding to talk to both child/young person & review the TLST

Agency concern about a child or adult re CPCA (child over 16 years old):

Referring agency to complete TLST and DASH (if needed)

and refer to MASH if scoring Amber or Red.

Note as concern if scoring Green.

MASH to screen within **24 hours:** Adult and child safeguarding to talk to both child/young person & parent/carer & review the TLST and DASH (if needed)

If scoring high in Amber or **Red** score: Arrange a multi-agency CPCA meeting within **7 days** to review TLST, care and support and safety plans.

The meeting chair to follow the chair checklist in the Toolkit.

If low Amber score, refer to early help for further support.

High Amber & Red Scores: Allocate two workers to complete the TLAT and work through the toolkit with the whole family.

Aim: Work with the whole family through the Toolkit to reduce TLST and TLAT scores to **Green** level.
