## SUBMISSION CHECKLIST



The Council is seeking to dispose of the site by way of a long leasehold agreement. The Lease will be for a term of 999 years on FRI terms. The closing date for submissions to acquire the property is noon, 30th September, 2019. The Council is not required to consider any bid post this date. The Council is not obliged to accept any offer. Any offer taken forward will be submitted to the Council's Scrutiny and Cabinet Committees for approval.

Opportunities for parking on-site are limited. The Council owns lands nearby that could be utilised for parking. It is recommended that before any application is submitted the applicant consults with the Council to consider whether any additional land could be provided to secure the proposed scheme.
