

## Location

Colwyn Bay Waterfront has recently been upgraded and attracts thousands of visitors each year with its sandy beach and local tourist attractions. The Pier is easily accessible on foot, with good transport links, just a three minute drive from junction 22 off the A55 expressway.

## Description

The newly completed replacement Pier opened in July 2021. The 40m truncated style Pier features ironwork and ornate support columns salvaged from the original Pier using the 1934 colour scheme.
