To extend the opening hours of the premises on Thursday nights until 00:30 and on Friday and Saturday until 02:30 hours. To add further conditions under Annex 2 of the premises licence. To add non-standard timings to all licensable activities for New Year's Eve. To amend the last entry for patrons on Thursday from 23.45 and on Friday and Saturday from 01.30 From end of the permitted hours on New Year's Eve until the start of the permitted hours on New Year's Day.

In accordance with S.158 of the Licensing Act 2003:

A person commits an offence if he knowingly or recklessly makes a false statement in or in connection with an application for the grant, variation, transfer or review of a premises licence or club premises certificate, an application for a provisional statement. A person guilty of an offence under section 158 is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale.
