

Example Hackney Test – Please choose only one answer and mark the box clearly

Section 1 is made up of 10 questions relating to the Highway Code and general legislation relevant to Licensed Drivers. The pass mark for this section will be a minimum of 10 correct answers out of 10.

Q: 1-What does this sign mean?



Mark one answer:

- The speed limit is 30 mph.
- The recommended speed limit is 30 mph.
- The minimum speed limit is 30 mph.
- The speed limit for large vehicles is 30 mph.

Q: 2-You have two 12 year old children and one of their parents in your car. Whose responsibility is it to make sure that the children are wearing seatbelts:

Mark one answer:

- The parent of the children
- The children's
- No-one's; they are sitting in the back so don't need one
- Yours

Section 2 is made up of 5 questions about dealing with money and fares. The pass mark for this section is a minimum of 3 correct answers out of 5.

Q: 1 - A journey costs £4.20; the passenger gives you £5.00. How much change do you give back?

Mark one answer:

- £5.80
- £1.60
- £0.80
- £1.20

Section 3 is made up of 10 questions relating Hackney Driver Conditions & Vehicle Byelaws. The pass mark for this section is a minimum of 10 correct answers out of 10.

Q: 1- When must you disclose any convictions to the Council?

Mark one answer:

- Within 21 days
- Within 7 days
- Within 2 weeks
- Within 3 days

Q: 2- If your passenger is struggling with their luggage, what should you do?

Mark one answer:

- Be patient and wait for them to put it in the vehicle
- Give them reasonable assistance
- Tell them to hurry up
- Drive off if they are taking too long

Section 4 is made up of 5 questions relative to the zone you have chosen to drive in. This could be Colwyn, Conwy or Llandudno. The pass mark for this section is a minimum of 3 correct answers out of 5.

Q: 1- Where is Llandudno Football Club?

Mark one answer:

- Conwy Road
- Bodnant Road
- Maesdu Road
- Builder Street

Section 5 is made up of 8 further general knowledge questions. The questions will be CSE related and applicants will be expected to know locations of important places such as their nearest police station, hospital, train station, and so on. This will not be a multiple choice question and the pass mark for this section will be a minimum of 6 out of 8. Applicants should base their answers on the zone they will be driving in.
