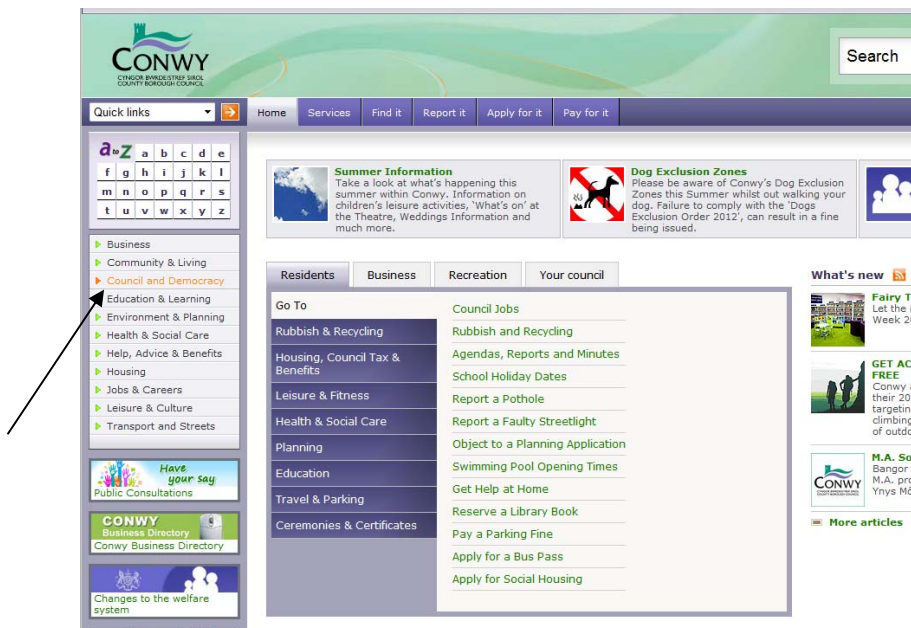


PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING A COMMENT ON-LINE

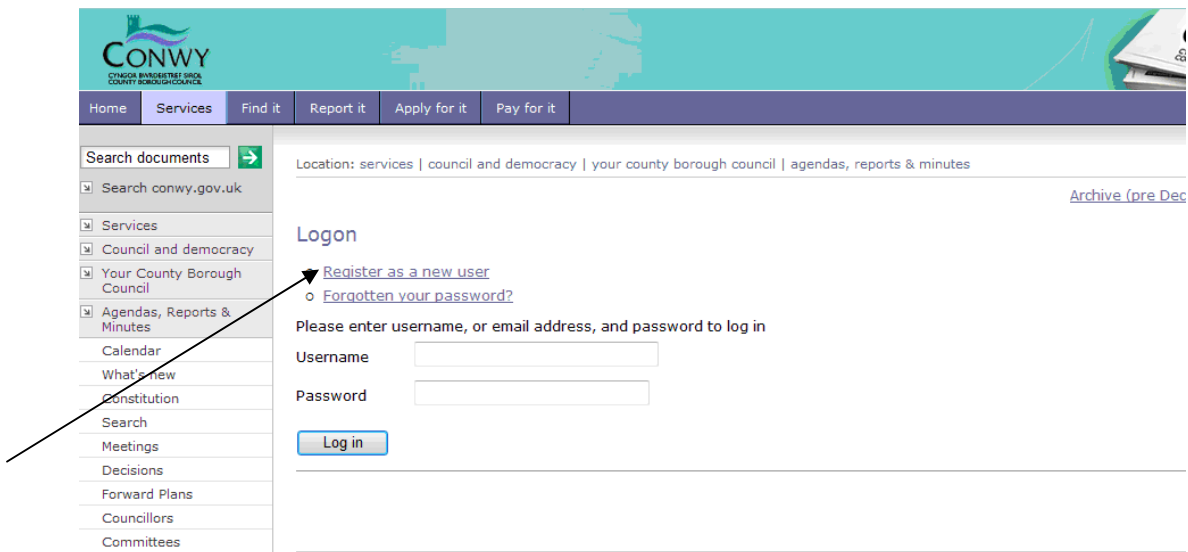

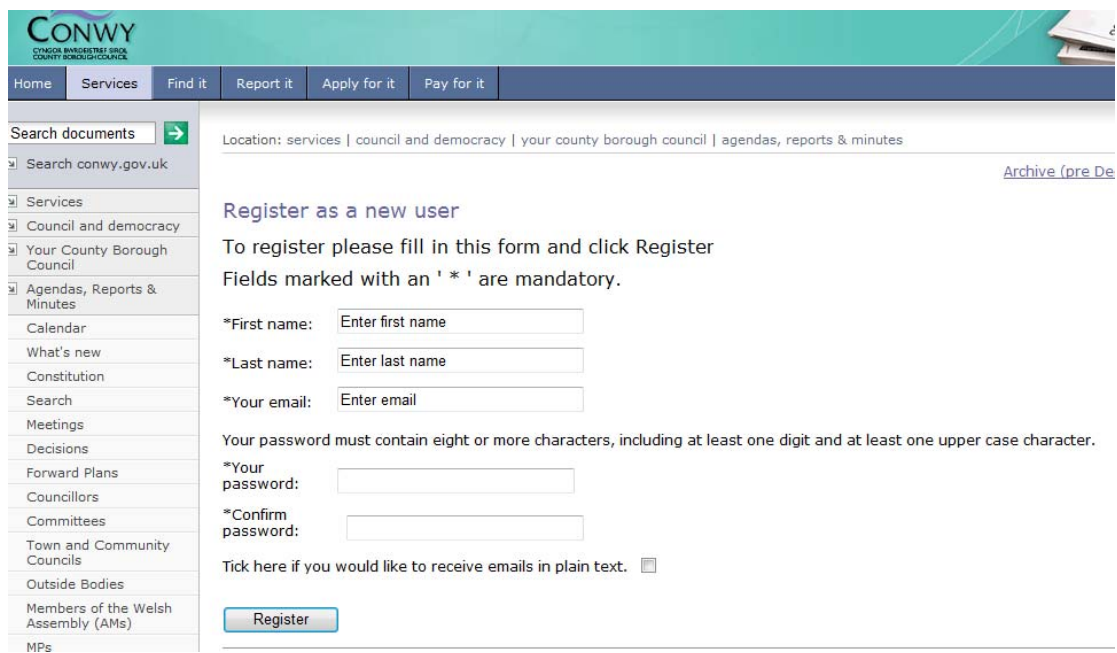

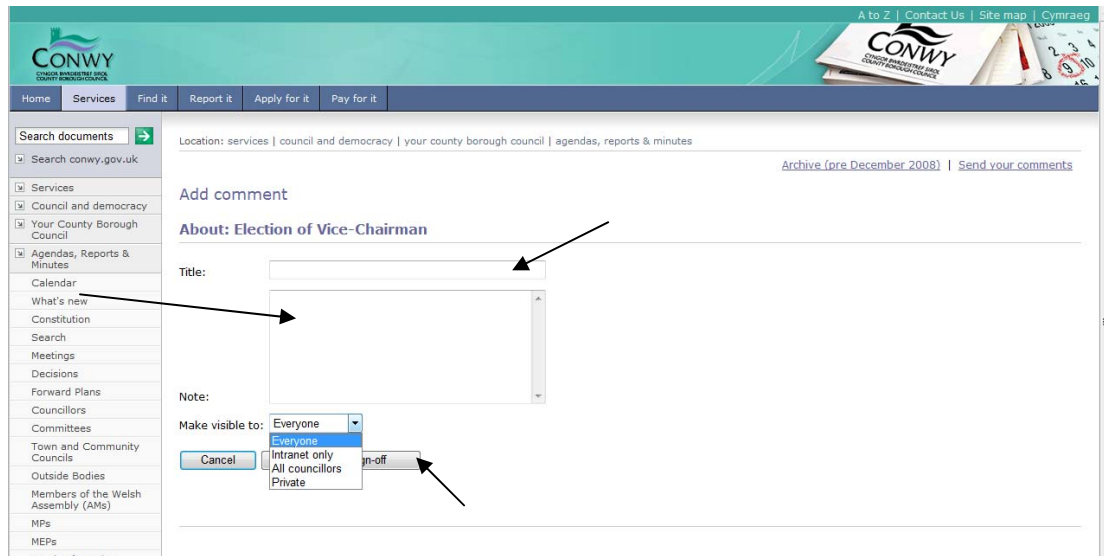
In order to create an account, click on 'Register as a new user'



To register, enter your name, email address and create a password



Once you have registered, this will take you through to a comments page where you can give your comment a title, enter the comment and select who you want to make your comment visible to.



The comment will then be sent to the committee administrators to authorise and following this they will then appear next to the agenda item visible to the option selected.

To subscribe to an update select 'Add a comment about item X' and then select 'Subscribe to updates for comments on this item'.
