Now that you are coming to the end of your compulsory schooling, you will be faced with making very important decisions which will impact on your future and long term prospects.

Many of you may choose to follow subjects offered at your home school however, others may wish to follow courses offered elsewhere.

In some circumstances there could be a clash of subjects on your timetable and rather than making alternative choices you now have the opportunity to follow your preferred subject at another education centre.

All educational centres have excellent facilities for sixth formers and wherever you choose to attend you will be given both academic and personal support in order to ensure that you have every opportunity to succeed. Some learners follow a course of study at college or another school and have relished the experience.

LINC Conwy was established in September 2011 which included every High School in Conwy and Coleg Llandrillo working together in order to offer as much choice as possible for post 16 learners. This arrangement has been successful as demonstrated in learners' examination results and also in a recent ESTYN Report. Wherever you choose to study, your progress will be closely monitored and regular updates provided to your home school.

Mae tri dewis gennych ym mis Medi.

- 1 Gallech aros yn yr ysgol a gwneud cyrsiau sydd ar gael ym mhrospectws yr ysgol a'r prospectws yma. Ym mis Medi 2019 byddwch yn gallu aros ymlaen yn y chweched dosbarth a ddewiswch chi a bydd gennych fwy na 30 o gyrsiau galwedigaethol a chysiau AS eraill i ddewis ohonynt. Cânt eu dysgu naill ai yn eich ysgol gartref, mewn ysgol arall neu gan y coleg.
- 2 Gallech adael yr ysgol a chymryd un o'r cyrsiau llawn amser niferus sydd ar gael yn y coleg. Mae rhestr o'r rhain ym mhrospectws y Coleg a dylai hwn fod ar gael yn yr ysgol.
- 3 Neu'n olaf, gallech chwilio am brentisiaeth sydd ar gael ar wahanol lefelau neu swydd, un gydag elfen o hyfforddiant ynddi fyddai orau.

Pa ddewis bynnag a wneuch chi, bydd cyfleoedd da i gael swydd yn rhanbarth Gogledd Cymru yn y dyfodol. Mae rhagor o wybodaeth am y rhain ar dudalen 8, 9 a 10.

DYDD MERCHER YW'R DYDD!

Os dewiswch opsiwn 1 uchod, bydd y dewisiadau cyrsiol sydd yn y prospectws yma ar gael ar Ddydd Mercher. Mae hyn yn golygu y gallwch ddewis astudio cwrs yn unrhyw ysgol uwchradd yng Nghonwy neu yng Ngholeg Llandrillo, ar yr amod eich bod yn gallu cyflawni'r meini prawf mynediad. Mae gan rai cyrsiau uchafswm dysgwyr oherwydd y math o ddysgu a wnânt. Os bydd gormod o fyfyrwyr wedi cofrestru ar gwrs ac na allwn redeg ail grŵp, byddwn yn defnyddio ffurflen gais y dysgwyr i ddewis yr ymgeiswyr fydd yn cael lle. Gwnawn ein gorau i adael i gymaint o ddysgwyr ag sy'n bosib ddilyn eu dewis gyrsiau a byddwn yn rhoi blaenoriaeth i ymgeiswyr Blwyddyn 12.

What Next?

There are three routes you can take in September.

- 1 You could stay in school and follow courses that are available from both your school prospectus and this prospectus. In September 2019 you will be able to stay on in the sixth form of your choice and still have over 30 vocational and academic courses to choose from. They will be taught in either your home school, at another school or by the college.
- 2 You could leave school and take one of the many full time courses that are available at college. These are listed in the College prospectus that should be available in school.
- 3 Or finally, you could look for an apprenticeship which are available at different levels or work, preferably with an element of training included.

Whichever of the 3 options you choose, significant opportunities will exist for future employment in the North Wales region. More information about these can be found on page 8, 9 and 10.

WEDNESDAY IS THE DAY!

If you choose option 1 above, the course choices in this prospectus will be available on a Wednesday. This means you can choose to study a course at any high school in Conwy or at Coleg Llandrillo, providing you meet the entry criteria. Some courses do have a maximum number of learners due to the nature of the learning. Where a course is oversubscribed and we cannot put on a second group, delivery staff will use the learner application form to rank applicants. Every effort will be made to meet as many learners' choices as possible and preference will be given to Year 12.

Having a whole day to study a course will allow for more intensive learning experiences. Staff will be able to arrange trips, invite visitors without affecting your other studies. You will be able to undertake longer tasks uninterrupted by the change bell and the need to move class. For practical subjects this should enable better outcomes and generate more motivation. Of course, you must ensure full attendance every Wednesday as any absence will be even more damaging to a whole week's worth of learning.

In general the day will run from 9.30am to 2.30pm which will allow travel time to the furthest centre from your home school. Transport will be provided from and to your home school.

All the courses are offered at Level 3.

GCE A LEVELS

An A Level consists of two stages: the AS represents the first year of a two year A Level qualification although it can also be studied separately. AS makes up 40% of the overall A Level grade. A Levels adopt a subject approach and are assessed in the main by external examinations.

VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

These qualifications include BTEC and OCR Cambridge Technicals and provide a practical, real-world approach to learning without sacrificing any of the essential subject theory. They suit learners who prefer to be assessed on how they are performing throughout the course.

Future employment opportunities in North Wales

The following information will give you an overview of developments in North Wales which will lead to employment. It is estimated that 40,000 jobs will be created over the next 10 years.

Attracting, recruiting and retaining people with appropriate skills is critical to replace a naturally ageing workforce in those growth areas which require greater specialist demands.

For employers, the additional skill to work within two or more languages is increasingly seen as an asset which can be marketed to improve the business. 81% of businesses in North Wales have Welsh speaking staff.

The North Wales Economic Ambition Board has published the North Wales Regional Skills and Employment Plan: <http://regionalskillsandemploymentplan.co.uk>. It highlights key growth areas, challenges and skills shortages some of which are explained below.

Demand Key Sectors Energy & Environment

This sector includes energy generation and its use, renewables and low carbon alternate fuels, energy efficiency, and waste management.

Advanced Materials & Manufacturing.

This area includes aerospace, automotive, chemical and petroleum, engineering and precision engineering, life sciences, materials and coatings, opto-electronics, sector specific IT and support services, packaging, professional services, marine, garments, metal and steel.

Future Skills Shortages include: Professional Engineers/ Scientists/ Technologists and Technicians

Construction

£2.7bn worth of construction projects are planned for the next 10 years excluding Wylfa Newydd. Future Demands include: Project Managers/ Civil Engineers / Architects

Demand Growth Sectors Creative & Digital

This key sector includes publishing, television, video, film, theatre, radio, advertising, PR, gaming, performing arts, and photography and continues to evolve as one of the main socio-economic drivers for North Wales. Employers report that skills in short supply from new entrants include sales and marketing skills, leadership and management, Welsh language skills and using sector specific software packages.

Health & Social Care

This sector covers a broad range of services including doctors, nurses, dentists, dental nurses, healthcare support services, pharmacy services, social care, childcare, elderly care, residential care, and domiciliary care. There are also links to activities within the 'Life Sciences' sphere including medical technology, pharmaceutical services, regenerative medicine and neuroscience.

The sector in North Wales faces significant skills and staffing issues in the coming years.

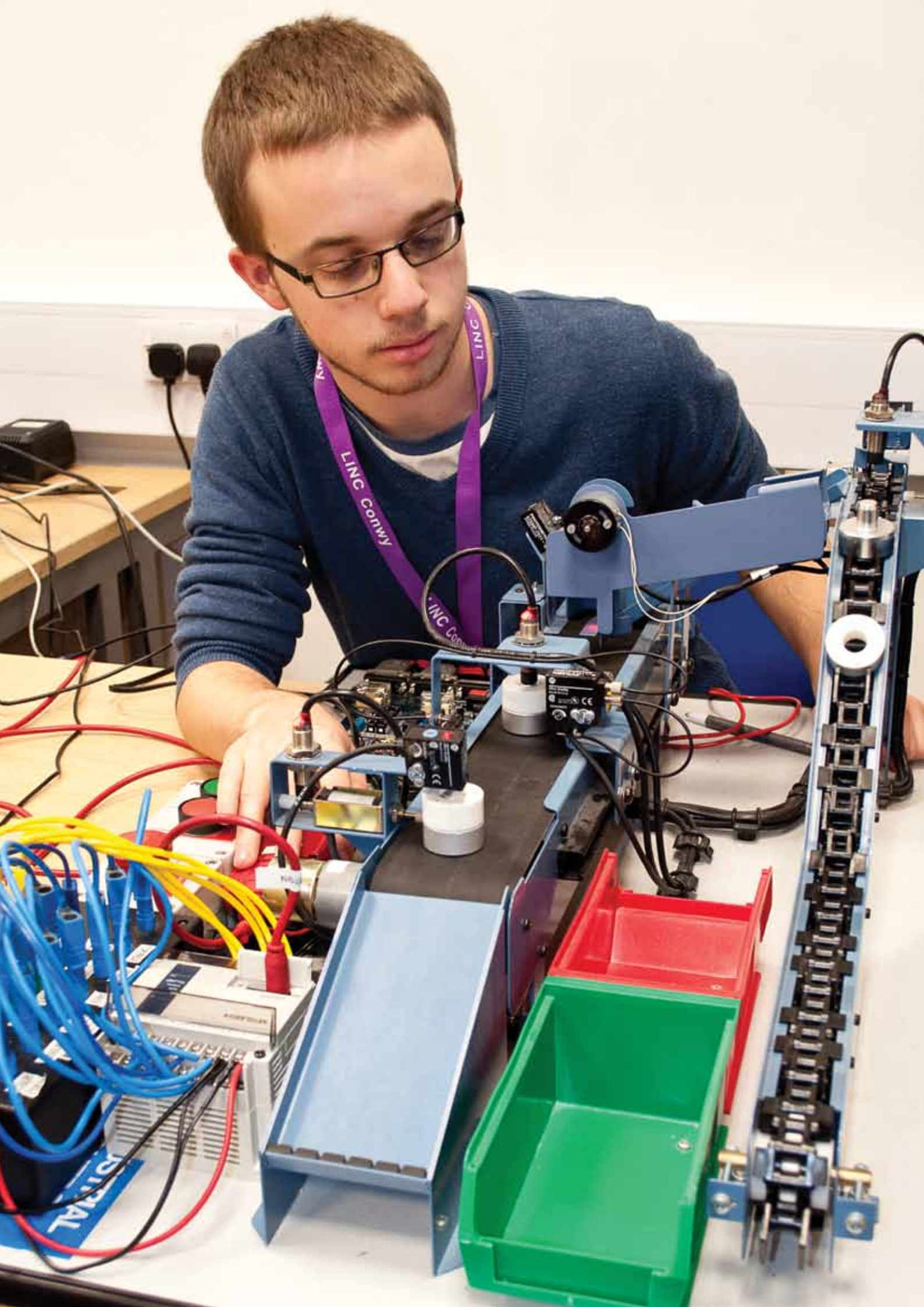

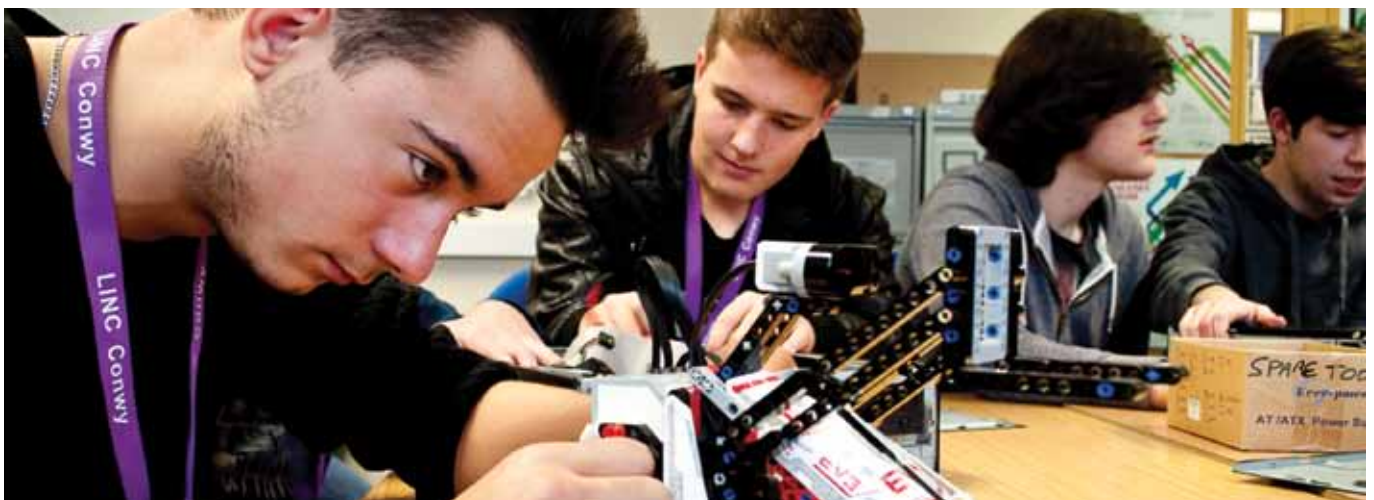

This course is designed to encourage learners to:

Unit 3 - (13%) Writing examination based on the study of a film

Unit 4 - (18%) Speaking assessment, including the presentation and discussion of an independent research project

Unit 5 - (23%) Listening, reading and translation


Unit 6 - (19%) Writing examination based on the study of one book

Entry Requirements:

Grade B or above in GCSE French Higher Tier.

What will you study?

- Social and Political Issues

Who is the course for?

The German A Level course is for learners who:

- are interested in and enthusiastic for language learning;
- wish to communicate at the higher level with confidence in German;
- wish to broaden their horizons in the future;
- are prepared to work hard.

The course will aim to:

- develop an understanding of the German language in a variety of contexts and genres;
- enhance linguistic skills and develop critical thinking through the study of language and culture;
- develop an awareness and understanding of the contemporary society, cultural background and heritage of countries or communities where German is spoken;
- foster a love of language and ability to learn others;
- develop research and other transferable skills.

How will you be assessed?

Assessment is divided into two units at AS Level and a further three at A2.

- Unit 1 – Speaking Assessment
- Unit 2 – Listening, Reading, Translation and Writing exam
- Unit 3 – Speaking Assessment on Independent research
- Unit 4 – Listening, Reading, Translation and Writing Exam
- Unit 5 – Critical and Analytical response to a Literary work in German

Entry requirements:

Grade B or above in GCSE German Higher Tier.

Your options after the course:

- acquire knowledge and understanding of the structures of authority and power within the political systems of the UK (Y12) and the USA (Y13 and the rights and responsibilities of the individual);
- encourage an interest in, and engagement with, contemporary politics.

Who is the course for?

- When you turn 18 you will receive the right to vote. If you've ever thought "why? what's the point? what does it all mean?", then this course is for you!
- Maybe you have a desire to change the world, in which case you will need to know how you can make a start: this course will set you off on your journey.
- Anyone with an interest in politics, contemporary society or law. Or you may just simply want to know how and why Wales, the UK, the European Union and the USA behave as they do!

How will you be assessed?

Ongoing assessment will be varied, including discussion, tutorials, past exam papers and essays. Final assessment is as follows:

AS (40%): 2 x one and a half hour written examinations

A2 (60%): 2 x two hour written examinations

Entry requirements:

5 GCSE's at Grade C or above, including English and preferably a similar subject such as History. The ability to be able to write a coherent essay is crucial, but no prior knowledge or understanding of any political systems, institutions or ideologies is required.

Your options after the course:

A variety of degree courses, particularly in the fields of History, Law, Politics, Humanities, Social Sciences and Public Service. A personal involvement in politics with a possibility of becoming a future Prime Minister. No other course in this booklet offers that option.....

Who is the course for?

Learners who have:

- a keen interest in making music as a hobby;
- an interest in listening to a variety of styles of music;
- experience of playing an instrument or singing;
- high levels of self discipline to rehearse and refine work for an audience;
- advanced social, communication and inter-personal skills to work with other musicians in an ensemble setting;
- those who want to study this or any subject at University or College level.

How will you be assessed?

Performing exams take place between March and April; composition coursework needs to be completed in the spring term and the appraising exam will be in the summer term.

Entry requirements:

GCSE in Music at grade B or above, or relevant music theory qualification (e.g. grade 5 theory). It is essential learners taking this course have regular vocal or instrumental lessons with a professional tutor.

Your options after the course:

A high percentage of learners who study Music opt to study at Conservatoires or Universities. The WJEC GCE course is rated highly by such educators as it prepares learners well for studying at Diploma, Advanced Diploma and Degree level. However, learners may also opt to pursue Music as a hobby.

It is essential that learners taking this course enjoy listening to and performing music as well as being willing to learn skills in composition.

- Dance or Musical Theatre Techniques or Variety Performance.

Who is the course for?

Learners who:

- enjoy performing musical theatre, as it offers a broad introduction to the Performing Arts sector, with an emphasis on core knowledge and fundamental transferrable skills;
- want to gain an insight into the nature of the industry and current employment opportunities, along with constraints and issues facing professionals working within the performing arts sector.

How will you be assessed?

Assessment is on-going with a variety of practical and written assignments demonstrating an ability to develop and use appropriate skills and techniques. Performances/ rehearsals will be recorded on DVD and you will complete written essays and reflections on work in progress and performances.

Entry requirements:

GCSE in Drama, or Expressive Arts and some ability or previous experience in singing and dancing to at least Grade 3 standard.

Your options after the course:

This course will provide the performer with a broad educational base for further studying, training and employment within the Performing Arts sector.

What will you study?

- Appropriate technical skills in black and white and digital photography.
- The development of artistic and creative knowledge associated with photography.
- Studying the work of other photographers in some depth.

Who is the course for?

- Learners who have aspirations of studying photography at a higher level or wishing to gain employment within the dynamic environment of photography.
- Learners can learn through the medium of English, Welsh-medium and bilingually.

How will you be assessed?

- In the first year, to achieve the AS Level, you will complete a single coursework unit equating to 40% of the full A Level. This is assessed via a blend of interim assessment and feedback, with final external moderation taking place at the end of the AS year.
- In the second year, to achieve the full A Level, you will also complete a 'Personal Investigation' plus 'Externally Set Assignment' which together will equate to 60% of the full A Level.

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 4 GCSEs Grade C or above. You will need to demonstrate a keen interest in Photography.

Your options after the course:

This course adds to your qualifications and helps you to progress. You will gain UCAS points and be able to use these towards your application for a Higher Education course. If you choose to continue your studies in this subject, Coleg Llandrillo also offers a Foundation degree in Photography.

PSYCHOLOGY

WJEC A LEVEL / COLEG LLANDRILLO

What will you study?

Psychology is defined as the science of the mind and behaviour.

The A Level course will cover six approaches.

- Biological, Behaviourist, Cognitive, Psychodynamic and Positive. Each approach attempts to explain human behaviour in a different way.
- You will also learn about how psychological research is designed, conducted and analysed, as well as looking at five contemporary debates in Psychology – from the reliability of eyewitness testimony to the ethics of neuroscience.

Who is the course for?

The course is open to learners wishing to:

- pursue a career in Psychology or who have a general interest in human behaviour. It works well with most A Level subject combinations;
- gain an overview of the subject, and assumes no prior knowledge. However, you should have a scientific and enquiring mind, enjoy extended writing tasks and be comfortable analysing data.

How will you be assessed?

The AS is examined through two written examinations at the end of the year. The A Level will be assessed through two further written exams at the end of year two.

Entry requirements:

A GCSE grade C or above in English or Welsh, Maths and Science.

Your options after the course:

You may decide to apply for an undergraduate degree in Psychology or related subject, or enter employment. Possible career paths include Health or Clinical Psychology, Education, Advertising, Sports Psychology, Marketing and Forensic Psychology or Criminology.

What will you study?

- Skills that are applicable to many working environments including Communication, Application of Number and IT.

Who is the course for?

Learners looking for an opportunity:

- to pursue a career within a Public or Emergency Service, e.g. Police, Fire, Ambulance Service, the Armed Forces, Prison Service and HM Revenue and Customs;
- the Subsidiary Diploma attracts the same number of UCAS points as an A Level and is an excellent choice for those wishing to progress to higher education.

How will you be assessed?

There is no final written examination as you achieve your qualification through continuous assessment. Assessment methods employed within the units include: individual research, group work, projects work, oral presentations, visual displays, written papers etc. Each unit carries at least two assignments. Successful assessments will be graded at pass, merit or distinction.

Entry requirements:

A standard level of Literacy and Numeracy supported by 4 GCSEs at Grades A – C. Alternatively, you may have achieved a related Level 2 qualification with a minimum of a merit grade.

Your options after the course:

The structured preparation for entry into a Public/Emergency service is one of the main themes of the programme. The BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma is recognised as an entry qualification by a wide range of employers and HE institutions.

- Compulsory units cover Government and Policies, Leadership and Teamwork as well as Citizenship and Diversity.
- Other units can include Physical Readiness, Crime, Police Powers, War and Conflict and Expeditions.
- A range of teachers deliver the course, according to their specialist knowledge, aided by visits and talks from members of the public services.

Who is the course for?

- Learners who have an interest in a career in one of the armed services such as the Army, or the Police, Fire and Rescue Service or one of the many areas of local or national government employment such as Emergency Planning or the Crown Prosecution Service.
- Learners who wish to follow a course that will inform them about concepts such as the Law, the Courts, the Media, Citizenship and Human Rights.
- It is a highly-regarded course which emphasises realistic, work-focused learning.

How will you be assessed?

Learners are assessed throughout the course; there are no terminal examinations. Assessment will be through written assignments and also witness statements of practical activities that you plan, do and review. This qualification is studied during Year 12 and is the equivalent of one full A Level. Successful learners can then progress to Year 13 to study the Diploma which is equivalent to two A Levels.

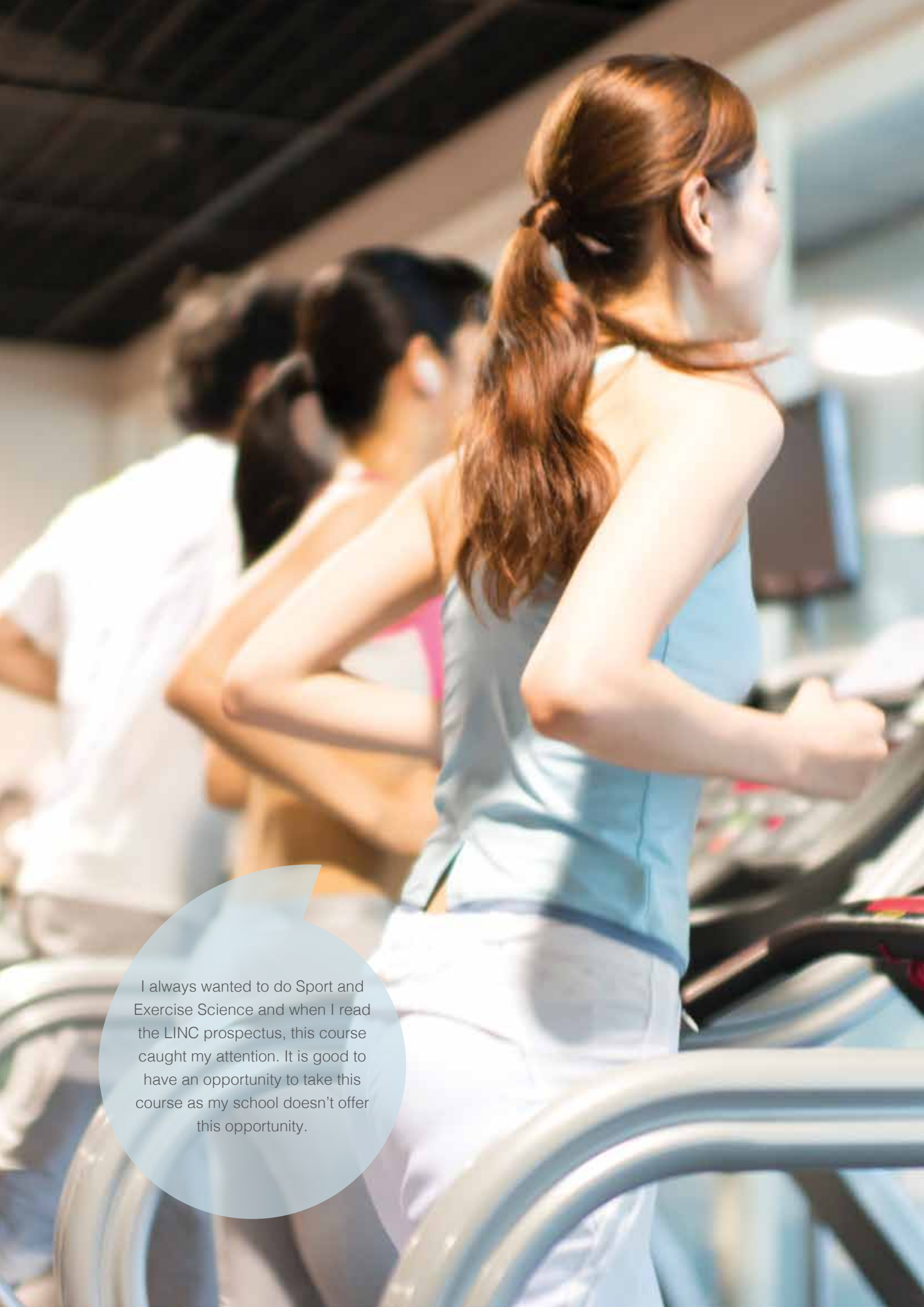
Entry requirements:

Who is the course for?

Learners who would like:

- the opportunity to enter employment in the sport and active leisure sector;
- to progress to higher education or obtain further professional vocational qualifications;
- the opportunity to develop a range of techniques, personal skills and attributes to contribute to a working life.

How will you be assessed?

This is a 2 year course with a 1 hour and 30 minute written examination plus 3 additional units. Tasks will be completed during lesson time and independently. Learners must complete and achieve at Near Pass grade or above for both mandatory external units and a Pass grade or above for the mandatory internal unit.

Entry requirements:

An interest in sport and active leisure and maintaining fitness levels.

This 2 year course is a Specialist Qualification in Outdoor Education that will lead to a BTEC National Diploma, equivalent to 1 A Level. The outcome is either pass or fail. If you pass you will get 32 UCAS points, the equivalent of a C grade at A Level. There will be an option to complete one year only and gain a National Certificate which is equivalent to an AS Level and is the equivalent of an E grade at A Level.

What will you study?

- Some units are classroom based but the majority are practical and involve off-site activities.
- Outdoor activities in at least two land based (Orienteering, Mountain Walking and Climbing) and two water based (Canoeing, Kayaking and Sailing) Outdoor and Adventurous Activities.
- There is also a land-based and water-based expedition each year.

Who is the course for?

Year 1 leading to a Certificate in Skills and Activities for Sports and Active Leisure (Outdoor Education)

The 3 units - Outdoor and Adventurous Activities, Skills for Land-based Outdoor and Adventurous Activities and Outdoor and Adventurous Expeditions will enable learners to:

- participate in exciting activities in the outdoors, learning and applying practical skills and techniques, further develop leadership skills and qualities;
- take part in selected land-based outdoor and adventurous activities and review your performance;
- to plan, participate in and reflect on outdoor and adventurous expeditions.

Year 2 leading to a Diploma in Skills and Activities for Sports and Active Leisure (Outdoor Education)

The 3 units - Principles and Practices in Outdoor Adventure, Skills for Water-based Outdoor and Adventurous Activities and Alternative Pursuits for Outdoor Adventure will enable learners to:

- develop knowledge of the underpinning principles and practices of the outdoor industry including all aspects of provision, function and good practice;
- take part in selected water-based outdoor and adventurous activities and to review performance;
- understand, prepare and participate in alternative pursuits for outdoor adventure.

How will you be assessed?

This course is 100% coursework and has no examinations.

Entry requirements:

At least five GCSEs at Grades A*- C or its vocational equivalent. It would be an advantage if you have already been successful in BTEC Level 2 Sport or Outdoor Education courses and know that the style of teaching and learning suits you, however, this is not essential. A proven interest in outdoor and adventurous activities.

Your options after the course:

After the course, you can choose to apply for a job straight away with one of the large number of outdoor activity providers in North Wales, where you would need further training. Alternatively, you could go into higher education to study for a teaching degree specialising in Outdoor Education.

Travelling to other schools requires commitment for the length of the course.

Q: Will I have to wear school uniform if I have lessons in another school/ college?

A: School uniform is not required when at college. If your school has a sixth-form uniform then you may be expected to wear this when learning at another school. Otherwise smart, casual wear is acceptable.

Q: What about lunch arrangements?

A: If you want to have lunch at your host school (the one you're visiting), arrangements will be made for you. When studying at the college, you can use 'Horizons' cafeteria.

Q: How will I travel to another school or college?

A: Transport will be provided free of charge but it will be your responsibility to turn up at the correct time. You should not use your own transport. However, if you live within walking distance of your LINC Conwy learning provider, you will be expected to make your own way there.

A: No. There will be some differences but you will be informed of these when you start your course. You will be expected to sign a Learners' Agreement which requires you to respect the rules of the learning provider.
