

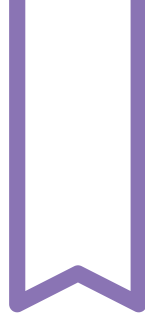

A Message from Conwy's Chief Education Officer

Dear Learner,

Now that you are coming to the end of your compulsory schooling, you will be faced with making very important decisions which will impact on your future and long term prospects.

Many of you may choose to follow subjects offered at your home school. However, others may wish to follow courses offered elsewhere.

In some circumstances there could be a clash of subjects on your timetable, and rather than making alternative choices you now have the opportunity to follow your preferred subject at another education centre.

All educational centres have excellent facilities for sixth formers and wherever you choose to attend, you will be given both academic and personal support in order to ensure that you have every opportunity to succeed. Some learners follow a course of study at college or another school and have relished the experience.

LINC Conwy was established in September 2011 and included every High School in Conwy and Coleg Llandrillo working together in order to offer as much choice as possible for post-16 learners. This arrangement has been successful as demonstrated in learners' examination results, a recent ESTYN Report and a Welsh Government review of post-16 education. Wherever you choose to study, your progress will be closely monitored and regular updates provided to your home school.

I hope that you will find the content of this prospectus to be helpful in enabling you to make decisions about the courses you would like to study.

Mae tri dewis gennych ym mis Medi.

1. Gallech aros yn yr ysgol a gwneud cyrsiau sydd ar gael ym mhrospectws yr ysgol a'r prospectws yma. Ym mis Medi 2023 byddwch yn gallu aros ymlaen yn y chweched dosbarth a ddewiswch chi a bydd gennych fwy na 30 o gyrsiau galwedigaethol a chysiau AS eraill i ddewis ohonynt. Cant eu dysgu naill ai yn eich ysgol gartref, mewn ysgol arall neu gan y coleg.
2. Gallech adael yr ysgol a chymryd un o'r cyrsiau llawn amser niferus sydd ar gael yn y coleg. Mae rhestr o'r rhain ym mhrospectws y Coleg a dylai hwn fod ar gael yn yr ysgol.
3. Neu'n olaf, gallech chwilio am brentisiaeth sydd ar gael ar wahanol lefelau neu swydd, un gydag elfen o hyfforddiant ynddi fyddai orau.

Pa ddewis bynnag a wnewch chi, bydd cyfleoedd da i gael swydd yn rhanbarth Gogledd Cymru yn y dyfodol. Mae rhagor o wybodaeth am y rhain ar dudalennau 36-39.

DYDD MERCHER YW'R DYDD!

Os dewiswch opsiwn 1 uchod, bydd y dewisiadau cyrsiol sydd yn y prospectws yma ar gael ar Ddydd Mercher. Mae hyn yn golygu y gallwch ddewis astudio cwrs yn unrhyw ysgol uwchradd yng Nghonwy neu yng Ngholeg Llandrillo, ar yr amod eich bod yn gallu cyflawni'r meini prawf mynediad. Mae gan rai cyrsiau uchafswm dysgwyr oherwydd y math o ddysgu a wnânt. Os bydd gormod o fyfyrwyr wedi cofrestru ar gwrs ac na allwn redeg ail grŵp, byddwn yn defnyddio ffurflen gais y dysgwr i ddewis yr ymgeiswyr fydd yn cael lle. Gwnawn ein gorau i adael i gymaint o ddysgwyr ag sy'n bosib ddilyn eu dewis gyrsiau a byddwn yn rhoi blaenoriaeth i ymgeiswyr Blwyddyn 12.

Trwy gael diwrnod llawn i astudio cwrs, bydd y dysgwr yn cael profiadau dysgu mwy dwys. Bydd y staff yn gallu trefnu triapiau a gwahodd ymwelwyr heb effeithio ar eich astudiaethau eraill. Byddwch yn gallu gwneud tasgau hirach heb i'r gloch dorri ar eich traws ac heb i chi orfod symud i ddosbarth arall. Gyda phynciau ymarferol bydd hyn yn golygu bod canlyniadau'r dysgwyr yn well a byddent yn fwy brwdfrydig i weithio. Wrth gwrs, mae'n rhaid i chi sicrhau eich bod yn bresennol bob dydd Mercher oherwydd bydd unrhyw absenoldeb yn andwyo gwerth wythnos lawn o ddysgu.

Yn gyffredinol bydd y diwrnod yn rhedeg o 9.30am hyd 2.30pm sy'n cymryd i ystyriaeth yr amser teithio i'r ganolfan bellaf o'ch ysgol gartref. Bydd cludiant ar gael i chi i'ch ysgol gartref ac yn ôl adref.

Neilltuwch ychydig o amser i ddarllen y prospectws yma. Mae'n rhoi blas i chi o'r pethau sydd ar gael i CHI ac yn amlinellu'r ffordd greadigol y gall eich cam nesaf mewn addysg fod mor ystyrlon ac amrywiol ag sy'n bosibl. Mae ein partneriaeth yn cynnig cyfleoedd cyffrous a fydd, gobeithio, yn rhoi'r dewis perffaith i chi!

What next?

There are three routes you can take in September.

1. You could stay in school and follow courses that are available from both your school prospectus and this prospectus. In September 2023 you will be able to stay on in the sixth form of your choice and still have over 30 vocational and academic courses to choose from. They will be taught in either your home school, at another school or by the college.
2. You could leave school and take one of the many full time courses that are available at college. These are listed in the College prospectus that should be available in school.
3. Or finally, you could look for an apprenticeship which are available at different levels or work, preferably with an element of training included.

Whichever of the 3 options you choose, significant opportunities will exist for future employment in the North Wales region. More information about these can be found on pages 36-39.

WEDNESDAY IS THE DAY!

If you choose option 1 above, the course choices in this prospectus will be available on a Wednesday. This means you can choose to study a course at any high school in Conwy or at Coleg Llandrillo, providing you meet the entry criteria. Some courses do have a maximum number of learners due to the nature of the learning. Where a course is oversubscribed and we cannot put on a second group, delivery staff will use the learner application form to rank applicants. Every effort will be made to meet as many learners' choices as possible and preference will be given to Year 12.

Having a whole day to study a course will allow for more intensive learning experiences. Staff will be able to arrange trips, invite visitors without affecting your other studies. You will be able to undertake longer tasks uninterrupted by the change bell and the need to move class. For practical subjects this should enable better outcomes and generate more motivation. Of course, you must ensure full attendance every Wednesday as any absence will be even more damaging to a whole week's worth of learning.

In general the day will run from 9.30am to 2.30pm which will allow travel time to the furthest centre from your home school. Transport will be provided from and to your home school.

Take some time to read this prospectus. It gives you a flavour of what's on offer for YOU and outlines the creative way in which your next step in education can be as purposeful and varied as possible. Our partnership offers some exciting opportunities which we hope will give you a perfect choice!

All the current courses are offered at Level 3.

GCE A LEVELS

An A level consists of two stages: the AS represents the first year of a two year A Level qualification although it can also be studied separately. AS makes up 40% of the overall A level grade. A levels adopt a subject approach and are assessed in the main by external examinations.

VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

These qualifications include BTEC and provide a practical, real-world approach to learning without sacrificing any of the essential subject theory. They suit learners who prefer to be assessed on how they are performing throughout the course.

Vocational qualifications have equal status to A levels

Beth fyddwch yn astudio?

Amrywiaeth o brofiadau a fydd yn cynnwys:

- archwilio ystod o dechnegau ffasiwn a thecstilau;
- tynnu lluniau gan ddefnyddio amrywiaeth o ddulliau a chyfryngau ar amrywiaeth o feintiau gan gynnwys defnyddio llyfr brasluniau/dyddlyfrau i gofnodi eu gwaith ymchwil, esboniadau a chanfyddiadau.

Y meysydd astudio fydd Tecstilau Llundrig a Gosodedig, Ffasiwn ac Ategolion.

I bwy mae'r cwrs?

- Dysgwyr sy'n chwilio am rhagolygon gyrfaol cyffrous, heriol a gwobrwyol mewn amrywiaeth o broffesiynau creadigol.
- Mae'r cwrs yn gofyn penderfynoldeb, dyfalbarhad, ymroddiad a thalent yn ogystal â gweithio'n annibynnol y tu allan i amser gwersi. Bydd angen i fyfyrwyr brynu'r defnyddiau angenrheidiol ar gyfer bob uned/ arholiad. Byddai peiriant gwnïo sy'n gallu gwneud brodwaith llawrydd yn fanteisiol.

Sut gewch chi eich asesu?

Caiff eich gwaith ei asesu ar gyfnodau sydd wedi'u penderfynu o flaen llaw gan eich tiwtor cwrs a bydd hyn yn cynnwys asesiad cymheiriaid a hunanasesiad. Yna caiff gwaith ei asesu gan arholwr allanol ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn. Mae Lefelau A ac AS yn cynnwys profion 5 awr dan reolaeth.

Gradd C neu'n uwch mewn TGAU Tecstilau neu Gelf

Eich opsiynau ar ôl y cwrs:

Caiff y cymhwyster ei gydnabod gan yr holl sefydliadau ac mae'n arwain at gyrsiâu megis BA (Anrh) mewn Tecstilau/ Ffasiwn, BA (Anrh) mewn Tecstilau Llundrig, BA (Anrh) mewn Newyddiaduraeth Ffasiwn, BSc mewn Technoleg Tecstilau a BA (Anrh) mewn Marchnata Ffasiwn/Tecstilau. Dim ond rhai o'r opsiynau yw'r rhain.

ART & DESIGN: TEXTILES

A LEVEL

LEARNING PROVIDER: YSGOL JOHN BRIGHT

What will you study?

A variety of experiences which will include:

- exploring a range of textiles and fashion techniques;
- drawing using a range of methods and media on a variety of scales including the use of sketchbook/ journals as records of research, explanation and findings.

The study areas will be Constructed and Installed Textiles, Fashion and Accessories.

Who is the course for?

- Learners looking for exciting, challenging and rewarding career prospects within a variety of creative professions.
- The course requires determination, perseverance, dedication and talent as well as independent learning out of lesson time. Learners will need to purchase the necessary materials for each unit/exam. A sewing machine capable of free hand embroidery would be advantageous.

How will you be assessed?

At pre-determined intervals by your course tutor to include peer and self assessment. Work will then be assessed by an external examiner at the end of the year. Both AS and A Level include 5hr controlled tests.

Entry Requirements:

Grade C or above in GCSE Textiles or Art

Your options after the course:

The qualification is recognised by all institutes and leads onto courses such as BA (Hons) Textiles/ Fashion, BA (Hons) Constructed Textiles, BA (Hons) Fashion Journalism, BSc Textiles Technology and BA (Hons) Textiles/Fashion Marketing. These are just a few options.

Beth fyddwch chi'n ei astudio?

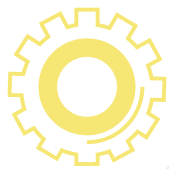

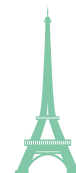

Grade B or above in GCSE French Higher Tier

Who is the course for?

The German A Level course is for learners who:

- are interested in and enthusiastic for language learning;

The course will aim to:

- develop an understanding of the German language in a variety of contexts and genres;
- enhance linguistic skills and develop critical thinking through the study of language and culture;
- develop an awareness and understanding of the contemporary society, cultural background and heritage of countries or communities where German is spoken;
- foster a love of language and ability to learn others;
- develop research and other transferable skills.

How will you be assessed?

Assessment is divided into two units at AS Level and a further three at A2.

- Unit 1 – Speaking Assessment
- Unit 2 – Listening, Reading, Translation and Writing exam
- Unit 3 – Speaking Assessment on Independent research
- Unit 4 – Listening, Reading, Translation and Writing Exam
- Unit 5 – Critical and Analytical response to a Literary work in German

Entry Requirements:

Grade B or above in GCSE German Higher Tier.

Your options after the course:

German can be studied as a single or joint degree alongside other subjects at university level. A foreign language qualification is an attractive one to have in the eyes of any future employer or when applying to any university, especially in the current global economy. In the world of work, the following professionals can benefit from having a foreign language such as German: doctors, nurses, chefs, sales managers, salesmen, teachers, marketing directors, buyers, pilots, bankers, librarians, engineers, accountants, couriers, lawyers, waiters, shop assistants, ferry crew, tour operators, civil service, telecommunications, aeroplane designers, secretaries, insurance agents, international publishers, armed forces, merchant shipping, just to mention a few.

How will you be assessed?

The course is divided into six units. Two AS units and four A2 units: two units plus two A2 units relating to a chosen pathway. 50% internal assessment and 50% external assessment.

Entry Requirements:

The qualification provides a suitable progression route for learners who have studied Level 2 qualifications within the health and social care, and childcare course. The course is also suitable for learners who have not previously studied Health and Social Care but who are capable of A Level study.

Your options after the course:

Progression into employment at trainee level within a range of health, social care and child care environments. Progression into further qualifications in a variety of HND or degree level courses in health, social care and child care related subjects such as midwifery.

Who is the course for?

Learners who want:

- a coherent introduction to the study of law
- an overview of different aspects of law
- to explore the mechanisms via which law grows and develops as society changes.
- the basis of an excellent route for the pursuit of a career in the legal sector

How will you be assessed?

Two compulsory units are studied during the 1st year. One unit is assessed by an external exam and the other is assessed internally.

In the 2nd year the compulsory subject (Applying the Law) is assessed via an external exam. The course then allows the optional subject to be assessed internally.

Entry Requirements:

Due to the demanding nature of this course, candidates are required to hold at least 5 GCSEs at grade C or above, including a Humanities subject and at least a grade B in English Language.

Your options after the course:

The course runs over 2 years and is equivalent in size to 1 A level. The qualification gives a comprehensible starter to the study of law and provides the basis of a first-rate route for the pursuit of a career in the legal sector.

What will you study?

This course deals with the maintenance of health and the prevention and treatment of diseases. As well as learning the fundamentals of Biology, Biological Systems and Human Health and Disease, the qualification covers health, physiology, pharmacology, physiological measurement, clinical testing and medical research.

Who is the course for?

The Medical Science WJEC Level 3 Diploma is:

- designed to support learner progression into higher education or employment;
- for learners who have a keen interest in science but who also want to develop their interpersonal and practical skills;
- perfect for learners who would like to pursue a career in the health related or science related Sector.

This course should not be taken in conjunction with other science A levels.

How will you be assessed?

The course is a mixture of internally and externally assessed tasks accounting for over 60% of the course, and two examinations accounting for the remainder of the course. It is worth noting that in order to gain A* - C grades there is a minimum mark that must be achieved in these examinations.

Entry Requirements:

- A minimum of a C or equivalent in a Science course.
- A minimum of a C in Maths and English.

Your options after the course:

This qualification aims to equip learners with scientific knowledge and understanding, as well as practical skills that would support progression to a range of job roles within health care or life sciences. Alternatively there would also be opportunities to progress to job roles within the physiological sciences, working directly with patients, measuring and evaluating particular organs and systems, such as scientists working in neurophysiology recording the electrical activity in the brain.

- an interest in listening to a variety of styles of music;
- experience of playing an instrument or singing;
- high levels of self discipline to rehearse and refine work for an audience;
- advanced social, communication and inter-personal skills to work with other musicians in an ensemble setting;
- those who want to study this or any subject at University or College level.

How will you be assessed?

Performing exams take place between March and April; composition coursework needs to be completed in the spring term and the appraising exam will be in the summer term.

Entry Requirements:

GCSE in Music at grade B or above, or relevant music theory qualification (e.g. grade 5 theory).

It is essential learners taking this course have regular vocal or instrumental lessons with a professional tutor.

Your options after the course:

A high percentage of learners who study Music opt to study at Conservatoires or Universities. The WJEC GCE course is rated highly by such educators as it prepares learners well for studying at Diploma, Advanced Diploma and Degree level. However, learners may also opt to pursue Music as a hobby.

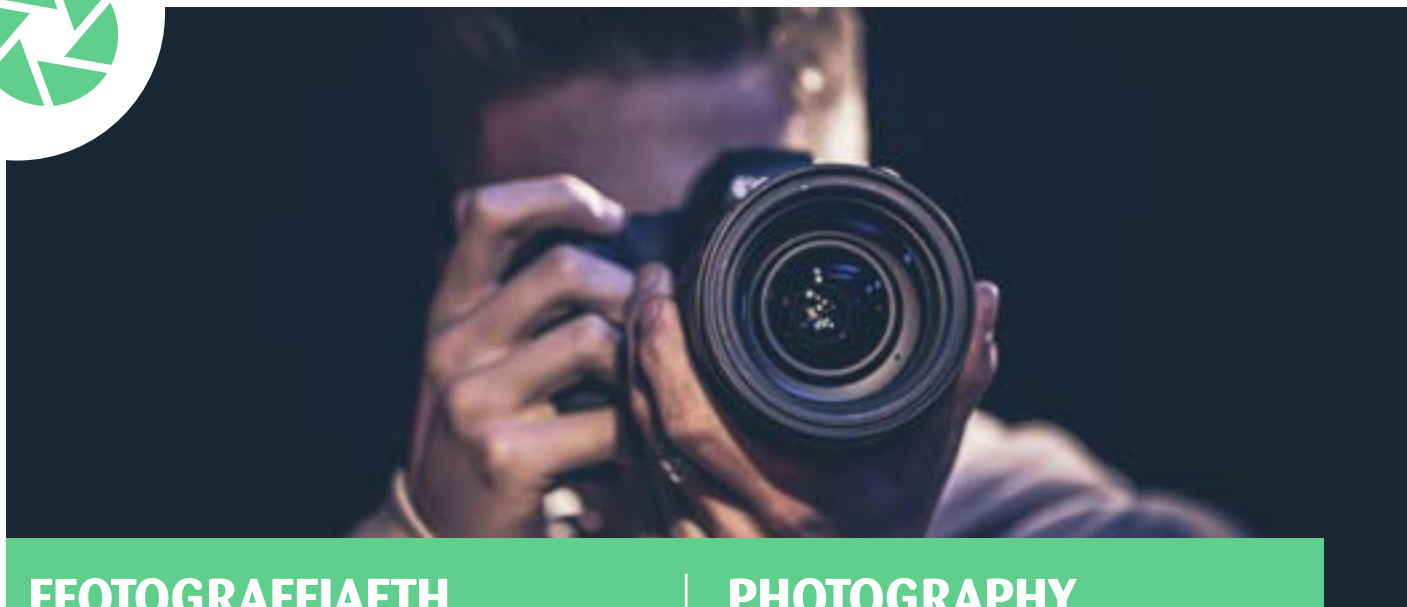

PSYCHOLOGY

WJEC A LEVEL

LEARNING PROVIDER: COLEG LLANDRILLO

What will you study?

Psychology is defined as the science of the mind and behaviour.

The A Level course will cover five approaches:

- Biological, Behaviourist, Cognitive, Psychodynamic and Positive. Each approach attempts to explain human behaviour in a different way.
- You will also learn about how psychological research is designed, conducted and analysed, as well as looking at five contemporary debates in psychology – from the reliability of eyewitness testimony to the ethics of neuroscience.

Who is the course for?

The course is open to learners wishing to:

- pursue a career in psychology or who have a general interest in human behaviour. It works well with most A Level subject combinations;
- gain an overview of the subject, and assumes no prior knowledge. However, you should have a scientific and enquiring mind, enjoy extended writing tasks and be comfortable analysing data.

How will you be assessed?

The AS is examined through two written examinations at the end of the year. The A Level will be assessed through two further written exams at the end of year two.

Entry Requirements:

A GCSE grade B or above in English or Welsh, Maths or Numeracy and Science.

Your options after the course:

You may decide to apply for an undergraduate degree in psychology or a related subject, or enter employment. Possible career paths include Health or Clinical Psychology, Education, Advertising, Sports Psychology, Marketing and Forensic Psychology or Criminology.

Who is the course for?

- Learners who have an interest in a career in one of the armed services such as the Army, or the Police, Fire and Rescue Service or one of the many areas of local or national government employment such as Emergency Planning or the Crown Prosecution Service.
- Learners who wish to follow a course that will inform them about concepts such as the Law, the Courts, the Media, Citizenship and Human Rights.
- It is a highly regarded course which emphasizes realistic, work-focused learning.

How will you be assessed?

Learners are assessed in one unit with a terminal examination. The remaining four units are assessed through assignments. Assessments will be through written assignments and witness statements of practical activities undertaken. This qualification is studied over two years and is equivalent to 1.5 A-Levels.

Entry Requirements:

Learners who achieve a Grade C at English alongside other qualifications at Level 2 can do well on this course.

Your options after the course:

The course is an excellent preparation for a career in one of the public services. It is widely regarded by the full range of employers. It also attracts the same UCAS points as and is a firm basis for further or higher education.

Mae'n hanfodol bod gennych ddiddordeb mewn gweithgareddau awyr agored ac anturus, ac y gallwch brofi hynny.

Eich opsiynau ar ôl y cwrs:

Ar ôl y cwrs, gallwch ddewis gwneud cais am swydd yn syth gydag un o'r darparwyr gweithgareddau awyr agored yng Ngogledd Cymru neu wneud cais yn uniongyrchol i un o'r Gwasanaethau Diogelu mewn Lifrai. Neu, gallech fynd ymlaen i addysg uwch i astudio cwrs gradd gysylltiedig neu ddigysylltiad yn y brifysgol.

This course is primarily an outdoor education course, delivered through a uniformed protective services specification. It is designed for those with an active interest in the outdoors and adventurous activities.

The course is made up of four units:

Behaviour and Discipline in the Uniformed Protective Services (Externally assessed) - Written examination set and marked by the exam board. There are many influences on the behaviour of those working in uniformed protective services. Some of the influences are within the control of the individual, while others are beyond their control. Understanding the relationship between performance, behaviour and discipline is key to improving the experience and effectiveness of those serving in the uniformed protective services.

Teamwork, Leadership and Communication in the Uniformed Protective Services - You will learn about leadership, investigating the different styles of leadership and how they are best used in the uniformed protective services. You will learn how to be an effective team member while developing leadership skills and will have the opportunity to apply these skills in different situations. You will gain an understanding of the different types of communication systems used and the importance of clear communication.

Skills for Outdoor Activities and the Uniformed Protective Services - You will develop your understanding of the skills needed to participate in outdoor activities. You will focus on the concept of good practice in the outdoor sector while recognising that it is essential to have a knowledge and understanding of the environment where the activities take place. You will study a selection of activities, focusing on developing your practical skills and techniques, which are essential for safe, efficient and independent participation. This unit will allow you to develop your ability in outdoor activities..

Expedition Skills - You will develop the skills needed to plan and undertake an expedition and will be given the opportunity to demonstrate these skills by planning, undertaking and reviewing your own expedition. This unit develops skills and improves the knowledge needed to lead a team on an expedition.

How will you be assessed?

The mandatory content (67%) is assessed by completing assignments, some are written and others are practical assessments. The exception to this is the external assessment (33%). This is the Behaviour and Discipline unit and is assessed by a two-hour online exam.

Entry Requirements:

At least five GCSEs at Grades A*- C or its vocational equivalent. It would be an advantage if you have already been successful in BTEC Level 2 Sport or Outdoor Education courses and know that the style of teaching and learning suits you; however, this is not essential. A proven interest in outdoor and adventurous activities is essential.

Your options after the course:

After the course, you can choose to apply for a job straight away with one of the outdoor activity providers in North Wales or apply directly to one of the Uniformed Protective Services. Alternatively, you could go into higher education to study a related or unrelated degree course at university.

A: You can study one subject on the LINC CONWY option. If your school is also working in a local partnership arrangement with a neighbouring school, you can also choose to study subjects offered there, as long as there is not a timetable clash. Travelling to other schools requires commitment for the length of the course.

Q: Will I have to wear school uniform if I have lessons in another school/college?

A: School uniform is not required when at college. If your school has a sixth form uniform then you may be expected to wear this when learning at another school. Otherwise, smart, casual wear is acceptable.

Q: What about lunch arrangements?

A: If you want to have lunch at your host school (the one you're visiting), arrangements will be made for you. When studying at the college, you can use 'Horizons' cafeteria.

Q: How will I travel to another school or college?

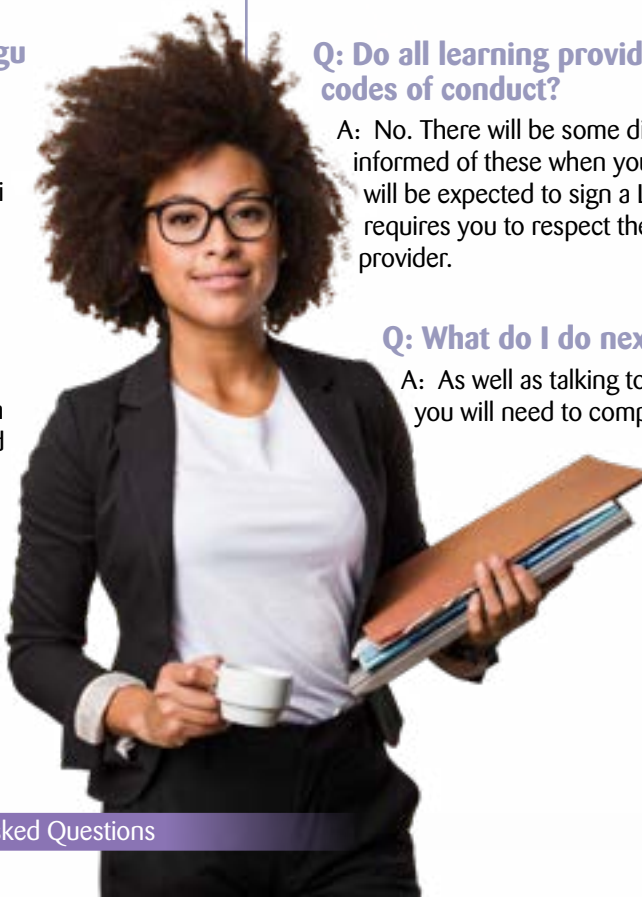

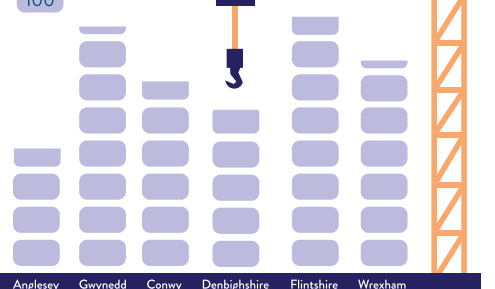

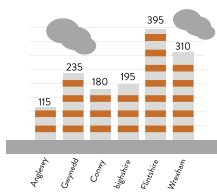

-Creative jobs will be more resistant to automation and artificial intelligence. 87% of creative workers are at a low or no risk of automation.
-Jobs in arts, crafts and design occupations are generally associated with higher levels of wellbeing.
-There is a strong case for creativity to fall into the STEM priority initiatives and change this to STEAM (A=Arts).
-The Welsh Government invested £30 million in the development of film and television projects in Wales between 2014 and 2019.

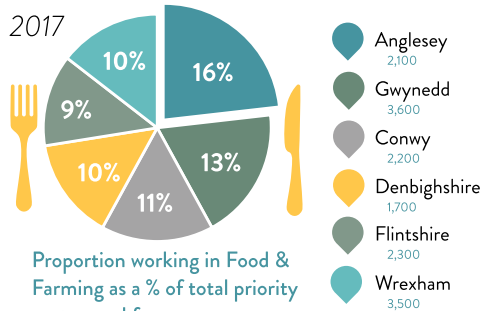

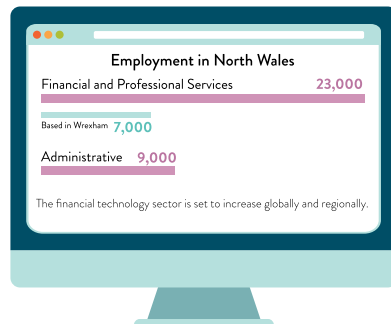
