

Conwy County Borough Council Coed Pella, Colwyn Bay, LL29 7AZ School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 41 and 43 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code 2018 that Conwy County Borough Council, having consulted such persons as required, propose as indicated below:

 Conwy County Borough Council propose to establish a new English Medium, mixed sex school to be maintained by Conwy County Borough Council on the sites of the existing Ysgol T Gwynn Jones and Ysgol Iau Hen Golwyn schools, for pupils aged between 3-11 years old.

As a result of the proposals outlined above:

- 2. Conwy County Borough Council propose to discontinue YSGOL T GWYNN JONES, LLANELIAN ROAD, OLD COLWYN, COLWYN BAY, LL29 9UA. The school is currently maintained by Conwy County Borough Council. It is proposed to implement this proposal on 31 August 2027.
- 3. Conwy County Borough Council propose to discontinue YSGOL IAU HEN GOLWYN, CHURCH WALKS, OLD COLWYN, COLWYN BAY, LL29 9RU. The school is currently maintained by Conwy County Borough Council. It is proposed to implement this proposal on 31 August 2027.

Conwy County Borough Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A consultation report containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees, the proposer's responses and Estyn's full response is available here: www.conwy.gov.uk/OldColwynSchoolsConsultation.

It is proposed to implement the proposal on 1st September 2027.

Pupils currently attending the two discontinued schools will automatically be transferred to the new proposed school unless parents/carers request otherwise.

The proposed new school will be a community primary school.

Conwy County Borough Council will be the admission authority.

The admission number at the new school in the first school year in which the proposals have been implemented is 60.

The new school's pupil capacity will be 425 with 25 spaces provided.

Home to School Transport will continue to be provided in accordance with Conwy County Borough Council's Home to School Transport Policy.

Conwy County Borough Council is satisfied that this proposal is the most appropriate response to the school's circumstances based on the information provided to Cabinet in the proposal report on the 11th November 2025.

Within a period of 28 days of the date on which the proposal was published, that is to say by **26**th **December 2025**, any person may object to this proposal via the following methods:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposal is to formally amalgamate Ysgol T Gwynn Jones (Infants) and Ysgol Iau Hen Golwyn (Juniors).

The Proposal to amalgamate Ysgol T Gwynn Jones and Ysgol Iau Hen Golwyn will mean the formal closure of both schools followed by the opening of a new school.

The proposed new school would remain located on two separate sites, under the leadership of one Head teacher and board of governors but with a unified management structure, mission statement, school values, logos, uniform, policies, and procedures.

The reasons for this proposal and factors considered were set out in the Proposal Document, approved by Cabinet 11th November.

This notice marks the start of a 28-day Objection Period from 28th November 2025 to 26th December 2025 and sets out the address to which objections in writing may be submitted.
