

YOUR GUIDE TO ASSISTED SCHOOL TRANSPORT

PUPIL UNDER 11 AND RESIDES OVER 2 MILES FROM SCHOOL

The LEA provides free transport where a pupil under 11 years of age resides over 2 miles from the nearest suitable school.

PUPIL OF STATUTORY SCHOOL AGE, OVER 11 AND RESIDES OVER 3 MILES FROM SCHOOL

The LEA provides free transport where a pupil of statutory school age, over 11 resides over 3 miles from the nearest suitable school.

CONCESSIONARY FARES

Concessionary seats may be available on certain routes for pupils who do not qualify under any of the above criteria. Charges will be subject to annual review. For further information, please contact the Transport team at Mochdre on 01492 577899.

MEDICAL GROUNDS

Transport may be provided where a pupil requires transport on medical grounds and no suitable public transport is available. Written evidence certified by a consultant or specialist must accompany your application. Such an arrangement will be subject to periodical review.

SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

Special transport arrangements may be made if a pupil has Special Educational Needs and has been Statemented by a County Statementing Officer to an identified school.

OTHER

If you feel you have grounds for assisted travel, please attach a covering letter and return with the completed application form.

MILEAGE ALLOWANCE/REIMBURSEMENT

In certain agreed circumstances, for example where a suitable school contract bus cannot be arranged, a mileage allowance may be paid to parents whose children meet one of the above criteria and are able to transport them to and from school.
