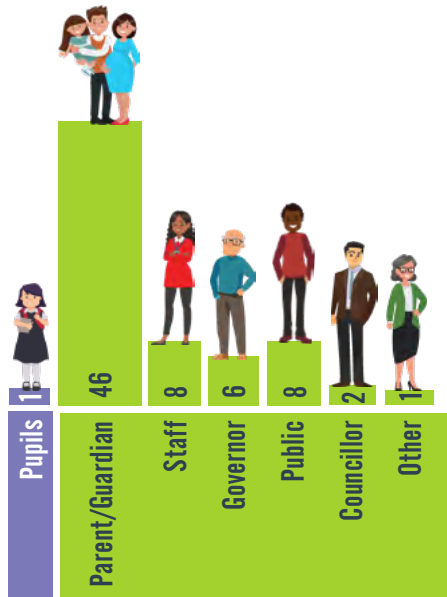

Do you think building improvement is required?



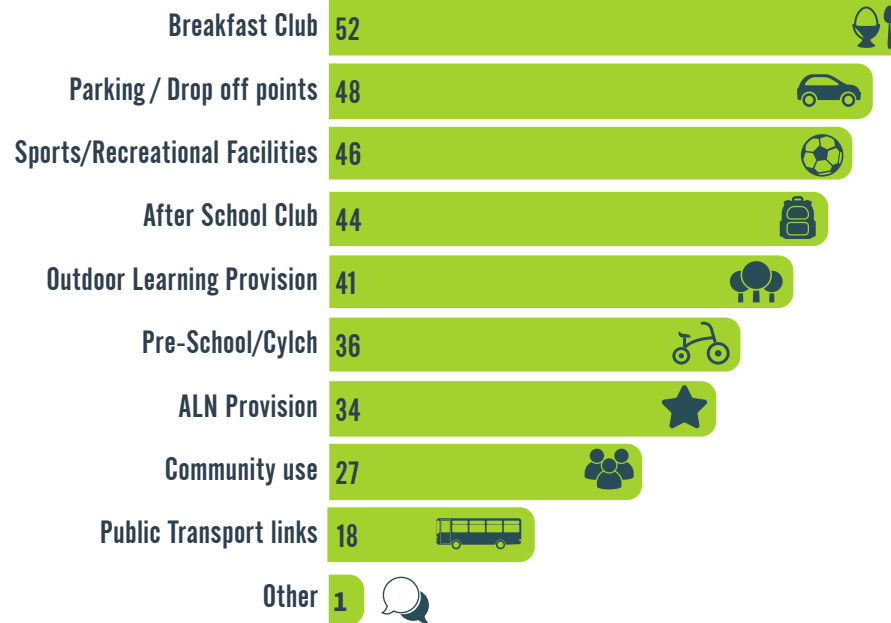

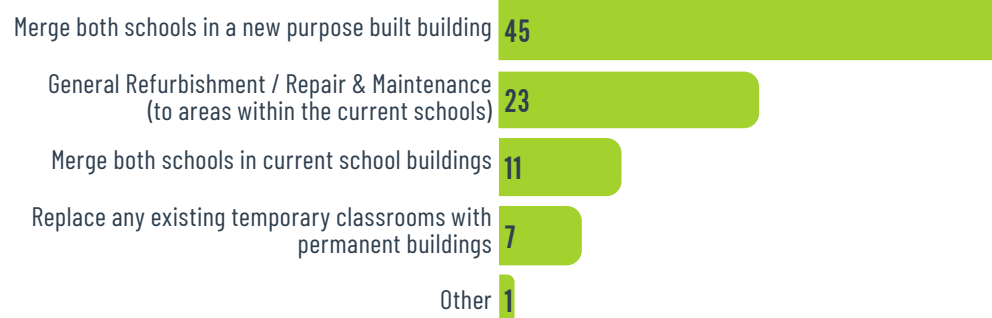


Who took part?

What 'additional' services are important to you in a school?



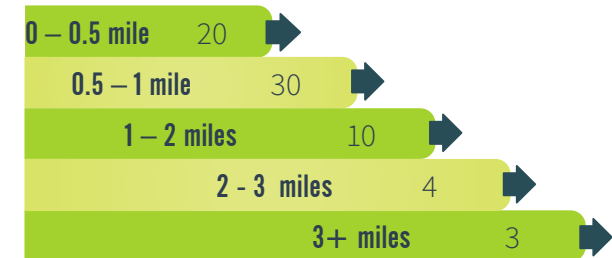
What would you like to see?

Do you think that building improvement is required at your current school?

**Some responses:**

Having visited other schools where this has happened the advantages are clear to see. The current buildings are outdated and need replacing.

It's important that the children have buildings that are fit for purpose to support their learning. Having all primary kids in one school will help their learning as no disruption / settling in, and be much easier for parents also.

The Heath site which is already owned by the council is an ideal site as there is enough parking and space to build also the current school fields could be accessed from there.

The school building, whilst old, is a lovely traditional school with some great opportunities for outdoor learning. Money needs to be spent improving the facilities in the existing school and considering opportunities for developing the existing site/ church next door.

Make use of empty schools for the benefit of the community

The existing schools should be returned for use by the community

I believe that the heath site should be considered as a possible place to build the new school.

It is nice having two historic and pretty buildings but they are tired and not really fit for purpose with growing class sizes etc. It would be nice to have a new purpose built school with facilities available for on site after school clubs etc without having to move the children through the village to another school.

It seems that both schools were built a considerable time ago and I imagine that to refurbish them both to

such a standard to meet the aims identified would be more costly and disruptive. I don't think there is scope to merge both schools together on either site and so a new, purpose built school would probably be the best outcome. Concerns exist about what will happen to empty buildings but that is a discussion for later in the project

Current school buildings are very outdated and no longer fit for purpose. Would be very difficult to make DDA compliant and provide outdoor access from all classrooms. New purpose built building would be best and at the heart of the community.

**General comments**

The above are provided at the moment and should definitely be at a new site. An improved outdoor area with easy access from all classrooms would be fantastic.

The new school's pupils should be increased as some children at present travel to schools in Bangor etc. But maybe when a new school is built they might decide to move school.

We need a much more modern 21'st century school.

I do not think that the proposed housing development should be affecting the progress of the new school as it currently is. It is about time CCBC pulled their finger out, stop dragging their feet in the hope that the housing developers will fund the school build!

Car parking is an absolute priority when considering a new site and the possible merging of both schools and potential increase in pupils when new housing is built.

Good safe drop off points needed when unable to walk to school

Not just after school club but broader range of activities - e.g. sport is currently good (MW Sports) but not so good on music/instruments and art/creative or "tech" stuff. Learning to Bee is great. Lack of After school club in babanod itself is probably the main issue - really not good to have to walk them to the other school and we haven't used it for this reason.

I support the application - New School and new site

Concerned about leaving a hole in the middle of the village if relocating to a new site. Reducing footfall to the local shops. Concerned about using green field sites to build a new school when we have empty building and site in the village.

Children at Llanfairfechan deserve the best. The schools do not currently offer pupils a 21st Century education.

Outdoor play equipment

Leisure and gym facilities that can be accessed by all community

One of the many benefits of a small school is the atmosphere and that your child is an individual who is known. This atmosphere is difficult to describe, or even create the formula for recreating. This would be important to our family going forward.

It would be a shame to see the heart of the village move to a site that is outside the main village on the outskirts. The school currently make good use of the spaces such as the town hall and the church. Would be god to know as soon as possible what the implications are of the current Church school - this may be different.

Much better facilities for the safety of the children and parents. Employ more Local Staff at the school who live within the local area.
