There is clear understanding that maintaining a Welsh language ethos within the school will support positive attitudes towards Welsh language use.</p>	<p>The normal expectation is that any pupils choosing Welsh medium options could be assessed through the medium of Welsh in those subjects at all levels and may be capable of progression to study at Post 16 through the medium of Welsh for those subjects.</p> <p>Most pupils would be assessed in English in most subjects and would progress to English medium Post 16 study.</p> <p>All pupils will be assessed in English but their Welsh assessment will be in Welsh.</p>

Welsh is taught as part of the Area of Learning and Experience (AoLE) for languages, literacy and communication.</p> <p>At least 15% of the learners' school activities (both curricular and extra-curricular) will be in Welsh.</p>	<p>English is the school's main language of internal communication as well as with parents and carers.
