The Dogs Exclusion (County Borough of Conwy) Order 2012

The Conwy County Borough Council hereby makes the following Order:

This Order comes into force on **1st February 2012**

2

This Order applies to the land specified in the Schedule 1.

Offence

3

(1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, during the times specified in Schedule 2, that person takes the dog onto, or permits the dog to enter or to remain on, any land to which this Order applies unless-

(a) that person has a reasonable excuse for doing so; or

(b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to that person doing so.

(2) Nothing in this article applies to a person who-

(a) is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or

(b) is deaf, in respect of a dog trained by Hearing Dogs for Deaf People (registered charity number 293358) and upon which that person relies for assistance; or

(c) has a disability which affects that person's mobility, manual dexterity, physical coordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by a prescribed charity and upon which that person relies for assistance.

(3) For the purposes of this article-

(a) a person who habitually has a dog in their possession is taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog; and

(b) each of the following is a "prescribed charity"-

(i) Dogs for the Disabled (registered charity number 700454);

(ii) Support Dogs (registered charity number 1088281);

(iii) Canine Partners for Independence (registered charity number 803680).

Penalty

4

A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE

SCHEDULE 1

Land to which this Order applies:

1. All land described in this Schedule being land which lies within the administrative area of the Council

(i) Land which is open to the air (which includes any land which is covered if it is open to the air on at least one side); and

(ii) Land to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment); and

(iii) Land which is signed at its entrance(s) as a "Dog Exclusion Area" (whether the sign uses those particular words or words and/or symbols having like effect)

And:

2. All Fenced Childrens Play Areas

3. All Multi Use Games Areas

4. All Tennis Courts

5. All Skate Parks

6. All Bowling Greens

7. All Recreational Fields associated with Education Establishments
8. The Playing Area of All Marked Sports Pitches, and
9. Betws Yn Rhos Play Ground, Betws Yn Rhos
10. Capel Garmon Playing Fields, Capel Garmon
11. Cae Ffwf Football Ground, Glan Conwy
12. Gyffin Playing Fields, Gyffin
13. Gower Road Recreation Area, Trefriw
14. Beaches including the seashore, foreshore and any slope or staircase leading onto the beaches as per i to vii below
 - i. Rhos on Sea – the area of the beach between the low water mark and the promenade wall between Rhos Point and the eastern end of the Cayley Promenade
 - ii. Colwyn Bay – the area of the beach between the low water mark and promenade wall between Victoria Pier and the promenade entrance to Eirias Park.
 - iii. Pensarn – the area of the beach between the low water mark and the promenade between the embedded wooden posts adjacent to the cafe building and the embedded concrete posts at the western extremity of the promenade.
 - iv. Kinmel Bay – the area of the beach between low water mark and the promenade between a point in line with Dinas Avenue Kinmel Bay and a point in line with Sandbank Road Towyn
 - v. Llandudno North Shore – the area of beach between the low water mark and the promenade extending from Llandudno Pier to Clarence Road.
 - vi. Llandudno West Shore – the area of the beach between the low water mark and the promenade extending between the two stone groyne
 - vii. Penmaenmawr – the area of the beach between the low water mark and the promenade from the east side of the café situated on the promenade and the slipway associated with the sailing club.
 - viii. Rhos Point, Rhos on Sea – the small sandy portion of beach unwashed by the tide.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Times during which the Offence is to apply:

1 to 13 of Schedule 1 This Order shall apply at all times

14 (i to vii) This Order shall apply between the 1st May and 30th September inclusive in any year.

14 (viii) This Order shall apply at all times.
