Housing Options and Advice

Conwy Housing Solutions is available to everyone and provides a range of services to assist and support you with your housing needs. The Team is based at Coed Pella, Conway Road, Colwyn Bay, LL29 7AZ and incorporates:


- **Homeless Prevention Officers** who will carry out an assessment of your needs, work with you to prevent homelessness, provide housing advice and options and signpost you to relevant services if necessary. They may also consider providing you with emergency accommodation for a short time until your housing situations has been resolved.
- **Home finder Team** who administer the Conwy Housing Register and provide an assessment of housing options. You can access advice on rent payments and repairs to your Cartrefi Conwy home from our Conwy Housing Solutions Offices.
- **HAWS Social Lettings Agency** provides a variety of offers to private sector landlords and holds a portfolio of properties that may be your housing solution. Registered Social Landlords (Housing Associations)

Registered Social Landlords are government funded organisations that provide affordable housing. RSL's undertake a landlord function by maintaining properties and collecting rent. Conwy Council no longer own any properties; all housing stock was transferred to Cartrefi Conwy Housing Association. All applications for social housing are now considered through the Home finder Team administering the Common Housing Register, which allows for one application to be considered for all Social Housing providers in Conwy below.

How can I apply for Social Housing?

You can complete an Application by phoning Conwy Housing Solutions on 0300 1240050, Option 1. The Home finder team are available:
Monday – Thursday 8.45am – 5.15pm and Friday 8.45am – 4.45pm

Private Sector Housing

What is Private Sector Housing?

Private Sector Housing differs from RSL's in that the accommodation is privately owned. Landlords usually request a Bond or deposit and First months' rent In advance prior to letting a property.

Helping to provide access to accommodation to those who may not normally be eligible for the private rented sector through homelessness, low income or housing need.

Each application will require supporting documentation. This must include photo ID and a current utility bill confirming your current address. One month's rent in advance plus deposit.

- Buy a local newspaper first thing in the morning on the following days of the week.
Make calls quickly, as properties go fast!

- Read supermarket memo boards, adverts in shops and post office windows
- Ask friends and family to look out for you
- Social Media can be an effective way of finding accommodation
- If you know of a property that has been empty for a while, push a note through the door with your contact details and ask if the owner wishes to rent the property
- Although many adverts ask for “NO HOUSING BENEFIT”, contact them anyway and explain your situation. If you have good references and a guarantor, let them know, as this may help. If you don't have references from previous landlords, character or employer references may be a good idea.
- You may be able to provide your own credit reference check. This is cheaper and can be refreshed.
- Negotiate the amount of rent the landlord is asking for; they may accept less.



By law, all landlords in Wales must register with Rent Smart Wales, and if they manage their own properties they must also have a licence from Rent Smart Wales. The registration and licensing scheme has been introduced by the Welsh Government to help ensure good standards of management for private rented properties. You should ask the landlord if they are licenced when viewing a property. You can verify if the landlord is licenced, or the property you wish to rent is listed and the landlord is registered, via an on-line check on the website: www.rentsmart.gov.wales
