# The Community Drug and Alcohol Service

The Community Drug & Alcohol Service aims to reduce the risks and damage caused by drugs or alcohol by working with other agencies and offering treatment and care. They provide advice, counselling, relapse prevention, harm minimisation, community or inpatient detox, medication, advice on sexual health, residential rehab, acupuncture, Needle syringe exchange, treatment options, Substitute prescribing, Hepatitis C screening, Hepatitis B vaccination, Signposting and onward referrals to other agencies.
