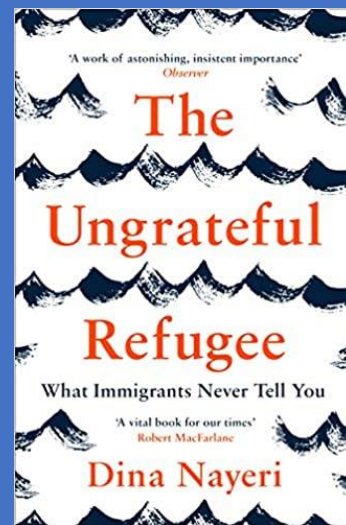
"We will develop our libraries into community hubs that provide a wide range of services and activities" (Conwy County Borough Council Corporate Plan 2017-22)

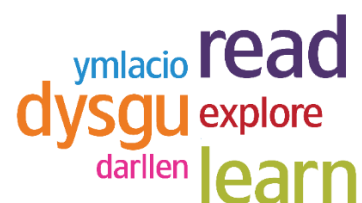
