Deddf Prifffyrdd 1980 - Adran 184 Croesfan Gerbydau dros Droedffordd a / neu Ymyl

Highways Act 1980 - Section 184 Vehicular Crossing over Footway and / or Verge

Nodiadau Canllaw i Ymgeiswyr

Gweler gopi o 'Nodiadau Arweiniol i Ymgeiswyr' gan yr Awdurdod Prifffyrdd ynghyd â chopi o'r amodau a thelerau er eich gwybodaeth. Noder efallai y cyflwynir amodau ychwanegol ar gyfer safleoedd anghyffredin.

Yn y cyswllt hwn, hoffem dynnu eich sylw i'r Telerau ac Amodau mewn perthynas â'ch dyletswydd i ganfod lleoliad unrhyw offer cyn dechrau tyllu'r briffordd. Ni roddir caniatâd hyd nes y ceir cadarnhad oddi wrth yr ymgeisydd ynglŷn â'r uchod.

Sylwer bod safonau parcio'r Awdurdod yn gofyn am isafswm dimensiynau o 4.8 metr wrth 2.6 metr o fewn terfyn yr eiddo (gyda'r hyd hiraf yn sgwâr â'r briffordd).

Mae Adran 184 o Ddeddf Prifffyrdd 1980 yn rhoi pŵer i'r Awdurdod Prifffyrdd roi caniatâd i alluogi ymgeisydd neu asiant yr ymgeisydd i wneud gwaith o fewn terfynau'r briffordd naill ai i adeiladu croesfan gerbydau, neu addasu croesfan gerbydau bresennol, ar gyfer eiddo neu ddatblygiadau.

Mae'r holl waith lle mae angen Adran 184 yn cael ei ddosbarthu fel 'gwaith prifffyrdd o bwys' ac felly mae pob cais am ganiatâd o dan yr adran hon yn agored i weithdrefnau ac arferion deddfwriaethol llym fel y nodir yn Neddf Ffyrdd Newydd a Gwaith Stryd 1991.

Notes for Guidance to Applicants

Please find enclosed a copy of the Highway Authority's 'Notes for Guidance to Applicants' together with a copy of the Terms and Conditions for your information. In the case of non-standard sites additional conditions may be imposed.

At this juncture, we would draw your attention to the Terms and Condition in respect of your duty for ascertaining the location of any apparatus prior to carrying out any excavations within the highway. Consent will not be issued until confirmation of the above

Please note that the Authority's parking standards require minimum dimensions of 4.8 meters by 2.6 meters within the curtilage of the property (with the longest length perpendicular to the highway).

Section 184 of the Highways Act 1980 empowers the Highway Authority to issue consent to enable an applicant or applicant's agent to carry out works within the highway limits to either construct a vehicular crossing, or alter an existing vehicular crossing, to serve properties or developments.

All works for which a Section 184 is required are classed as 'major highways works' and all applications for consent under this section will therefore be subject to strict legislative procedures and practices as contained in the New Roads and Street Works Act

Access Protection Markings ('H' Lines)

These are NOT provided under consent for Vehicular Crossings. Further details on their provision, including costs may be obtained from:

Please note that the person carrying out the works is required by the above legislation to hold a valid Streetworks Accreditation Certificate, and by Conwy County Borough Council policy to have Public liability insurance of £5 million.

You are therefore strongly advised to obtain estimates from suitably accredited contractors before applying for consent
