(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting & On Street Parking Places)
(Consolidation) Order 2006 (Amendment No 2) Order 2017 – Colwyn Bay
Promenade

The Conwy County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will amend the Conwy County Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and On Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2006 insofar only as it relates to Schedules 2, 4 and 6 thereto. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a Controlled Parking Zone on the length of Colwyn Bay Promenade as specified in the Schedules below.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Colwyn Bay Library, at the offices of the Head of Law and Governance, Bodlondeb, Conwy during normal opening/office hours and on the Council's website.

Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the Head of Law and Governance, Conwy County Borough Council, Bodlondeb, Conwy, LL32 8DU by 27 December 2017.
