The County Borough of Conwy (Tudno Street Llandudno) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2022

The Conwy County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to limit waiting to 90 minutes, with no return within 60 minutes in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below. Exemption will be provided for resident permit holders.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like and for vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the length of road to which the Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined on the Council website.

Schedule Limited waiting 90 minutes, no return within 60 minutes exemption for resident permit holders

Tudno Street Llandudno	North western side ; from a point 5 metres north east if its junction with Old Road to a point 6 metres south west of its junction with Church Walks.
	South eastern side ; from a point 30 metres north east of Llewelyn Avenue to a point 25 metres south west of its junction Church Walks
	South eastern side ; from a point 100 metres north east of Llywelyn Avenue for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction
