**The County Borough of Conwy (Parc Cae Seion/Bangor Road Conwy)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2019**

The Conwy County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like. Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order for vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Conwy Library and at the offices of the Head of Law and Governance, Bodlondeb, Conwy during normal opening / office hours and on the Council website.

Schedule – No waiting at any time

Ffordd Sam Pari	Northern side; From its junction with Bangor Road to its junction with Ffordd Sam Pari. South eastern side; from its junction with Parc Cae Seion for a distance of 12 metres in a south-westerly direction.
Parc Caer Seion	Both sides; From its junction with Parc Caer Seion for a distance of 48 metres in a north-easterly direction Southern side; from a point 15 metres east of its junction close to Tan Y Graig for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.
Bangor Road	Eastern side; from its junction with Ffordd Sam Pari for a distance of 40 metres in a northerly direction. Northern side. From its western extremity for a distance of 32 metres in an easterly direction. Southern side. From its western extremity for a distance of 45 metres in an easterly direction
