Shaping Conwy's Communities

Every community has the opportunity to develop their own Place Plan.

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Place plans are done by communities for communities. They can focus on a Town or community council area, a single village or a group of villages.

You understand:

- your community
- the people •
- the history
- what works and what doesn't.

Set up a community area team – get your community involved – let them know what's happening. Tell local businesses, organisations, hold events, use social media. More people will be interested than you think.

Find out more about your place – gather as much information as you can – talk to your community – hold events to find out what's important

Evaluate your place – draw out your Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats. Get people to talk to more people – include council members - tiny businesses - big businesses - young people incomers and old timers. They'll say what they think and help your evaluation.
