



LEARN THROUGH PLAY

Coloured paper lollies

It's a hot day, you're on the beach and you need an ice lolly to cool down ... pretending to be somewhere else can be so much fun for your child.

You'll need:

- Coloured card
- Lollipop sticks or similar
- Scissors
- Glue

Method:

- Cut out the coloured card into the shape of lollipops
- Glue the sticks onto the card and let the glue dry

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The benefits of this activity:

- Cutting out shapes and gluing things together will develop your child's fine motor skills
- Using these for a role play game will develop your child's language and storytelling skills
