## Handprint bunnies

Children love getting messy with paint. Why not try this fun and sensory activity for Easter?

### You'll need:

- Coloured paper or card
- Coloured paint
- A paintbrush
- A black marker pen

### Method:

- Using white paint and the paintbrush, paint your child's four fingers and palm (don't paint their thumb)

# LEARN THROUGH PLAY - Handprint bunnies

- See if they can separate their middle and ring fingers to make the bunny's ears with their fingers
- Ask your child to press their painted hand onto the paper/card
- Slowly and carefully get them to lift their hand off the paper/card
- Here's your child's bunny - they'll just need to wait a little for the paint to dry before adding the features
- Your child can use the paintbrush to paint some pink to finish off the bunny ears
- Use the black marker to make the bunny eyes, nose and whiskers
