Small world creations

Here are some ideas on how you and your child can create their own 'small world':

- **Dinosaur world** - fill a tray with sand, soil and natural items such as wooden stumps and greenery from the garden. Add different size dinosaurs and make a home/cover using cardboard or mud
- **Fairy world** - encourage your child's creativity and help them look for items that would make a fairy garden come alive such as small plants, coloured pebbles, soil and wood to make a bridge and a fairy door

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- **Farmyard** - create a farmyard using different materials such as cornflakes, porridge oats. Create different sections of the farmyard using Weetabix (or similar), blocks or wooden fencing to create boundaries. Add toy farm animals and tractors
