



# LEARN THROUGH PLAY

## Teddy maze

This activity will encourage your child to explore and problem solve the best way to get their teddies out of the maze. It also develops their fine motor skills and concentration.

### You'll need:

- A plastic washbasket
- String
- Some teddies/toys (different sizes if possible)

### Method:

- Place your child's teddies/toys in the washbasket

# LEARN THROUGH PLAY - Teddy maze

- Using the string and the holes in the basket, make a spider's web over the top of the teddies
- Make sure there are different size gaps so that some will be easier to get the teddies through than others
- Now encourage your child to get their teddies out of the maze
- If the gap is too small for the teddy to come through encourage your child to try another one
