## Topic box

This is such a versatile activity to do with your child. Just pick a topic and then help your child to find things that are relevant and pop them in the box.

### You'll need:

- An old box/container
- A selection of items that relate to your topic, such as:
- Holidays: shells, postcards, holiday photos, sunglasses
- Winter: a toy penguin, gloves, paper snowflakes

# LEARN THROUGH PLAY - Topic box

## Method:

- Put the items into the box/container
- As your child pulls out an item ask them to describe what it is, why it's in the box or ask them to make up a story

## The benefits of this activity:

- It will encourage your child's imagination and creativity
- It encourages them to use describing words and develop their storytelling skills
