Let's look at a book

- While your child might not be able to read yet, they love looking at pictures, listening to you and joining in with books and stories
- Don't worry about all the words - just talk about the pictures. Or make up your own story to match the pictures
- Your child loves to hear some of their favourite stories again and again. That's one way for them to learn words
- Your child will love you using silly voices to tell them a story

TIME TO TALK - Let's look at a book

- Create a cosy story space - cuddles on the sofa, a quiet corner, a bedtime story
- Find some special time each day to look at a book with your child
- Try a rhyming story. As your child becomes familiar with the story, let them finish the sentences
- Why not make a story box? Use a shoe box and decorate it and add characters. Make up your own story with your child. Have a go at using different voices for the characters in your story. Encourage your child to join in. Your child will love it!
